I have already written about one of the groups that I belong to called HHEY, which stands for Halton Hills Enabling Youth.

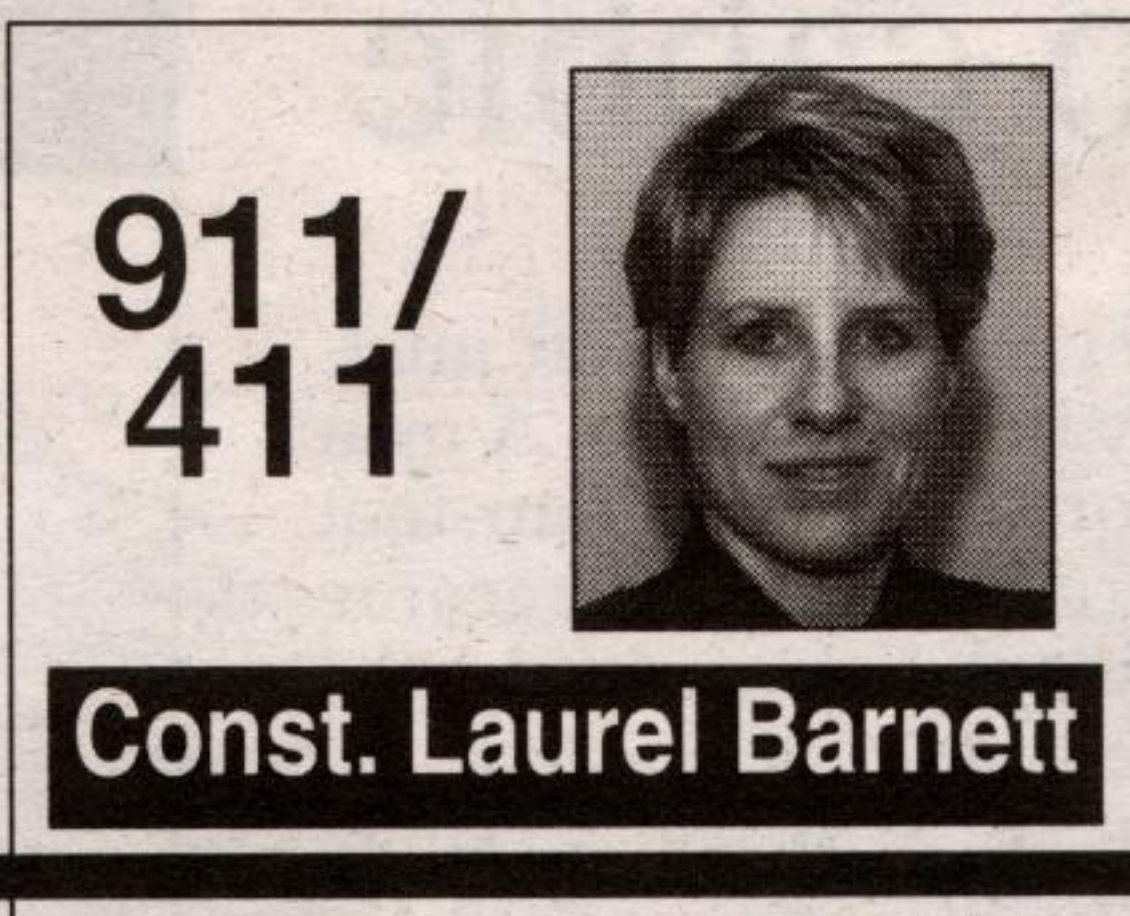

Our plan, which is still subject to change, is to have a mediator who has no

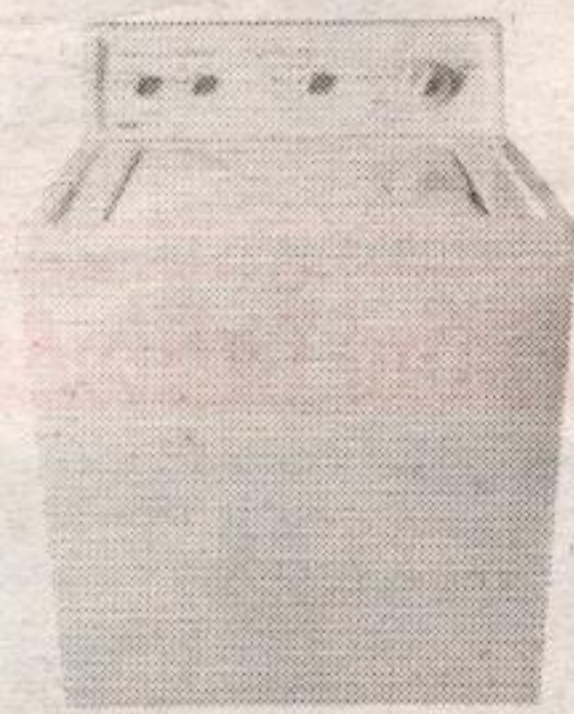

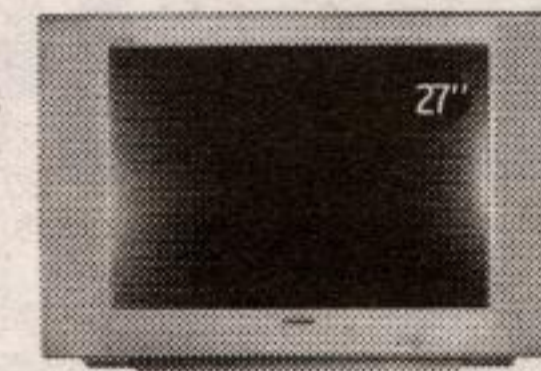

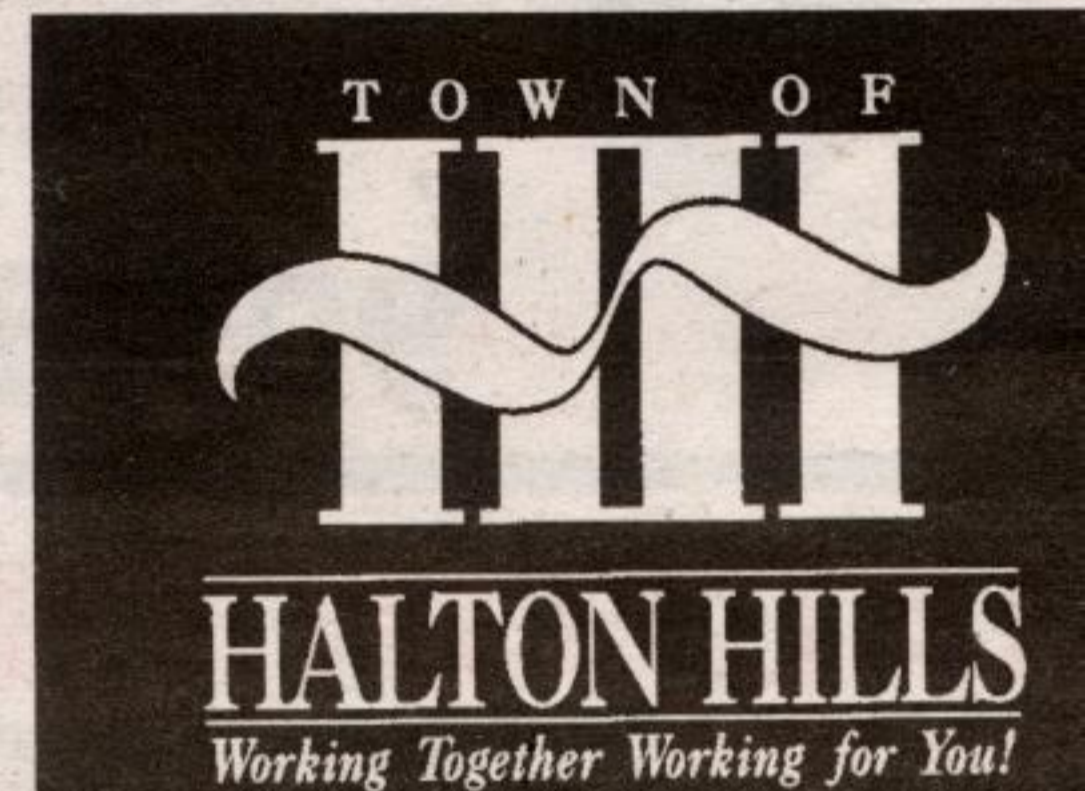
