



## Damage set at \$50,000 in convenience store blaze

No one was injured in a fire in an apartment attached to the rear of Choi's Convenience store Thursday afternoon.

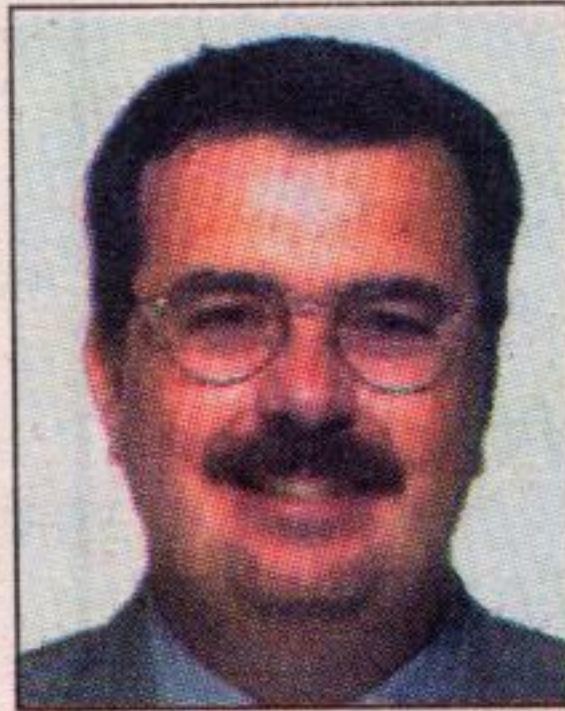
Halton Hills firefighters were called to the apartment, located at Main St. and Ewing St., shortly before noon and when they arrived they found heavy smoke coming from the apartment.

No one was home at the time. Firefighters spent two-and-a-half hours fighting the blaze.

Larry Brassard, chief of operations for Halton Hills Fire Protection and Fire Prevention Services, said the fire spread into the roof of the variety store and at press time damage to both the apartment and store was estimated at \$50,000.

"The crews that made initial entry to the structure did a great job at controlling the fire very quickly," said Brassard.

The cause of the blaze is still under investigation.

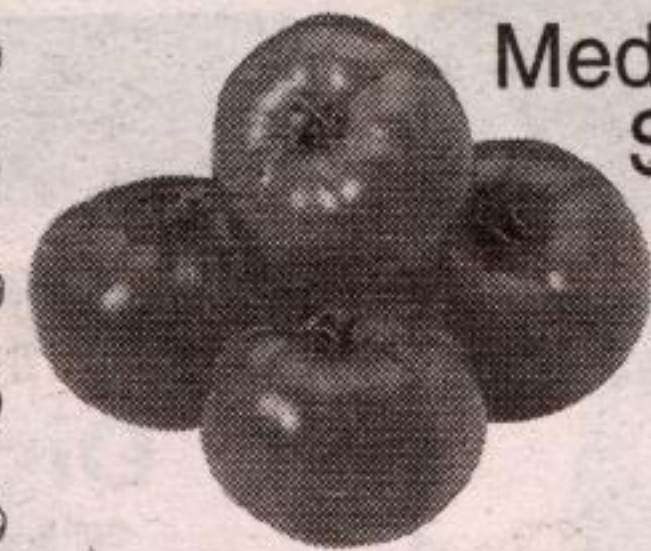

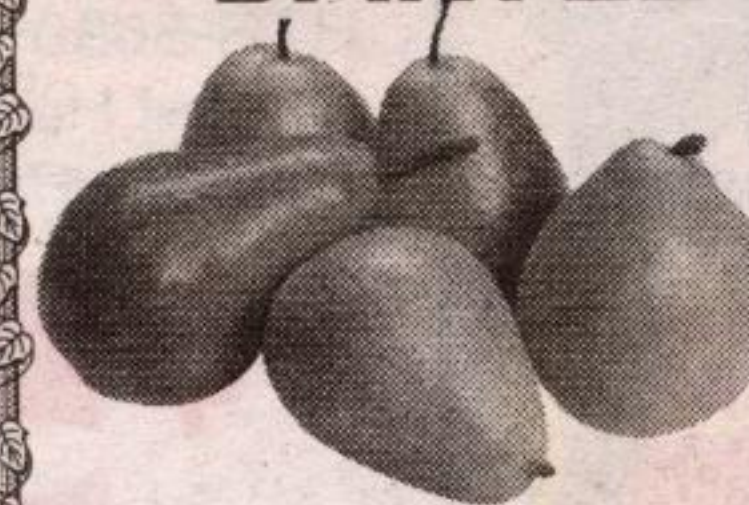
