As well, throughout the year residents can enjoy a number of special events put on by a hard-working and dedicated collection



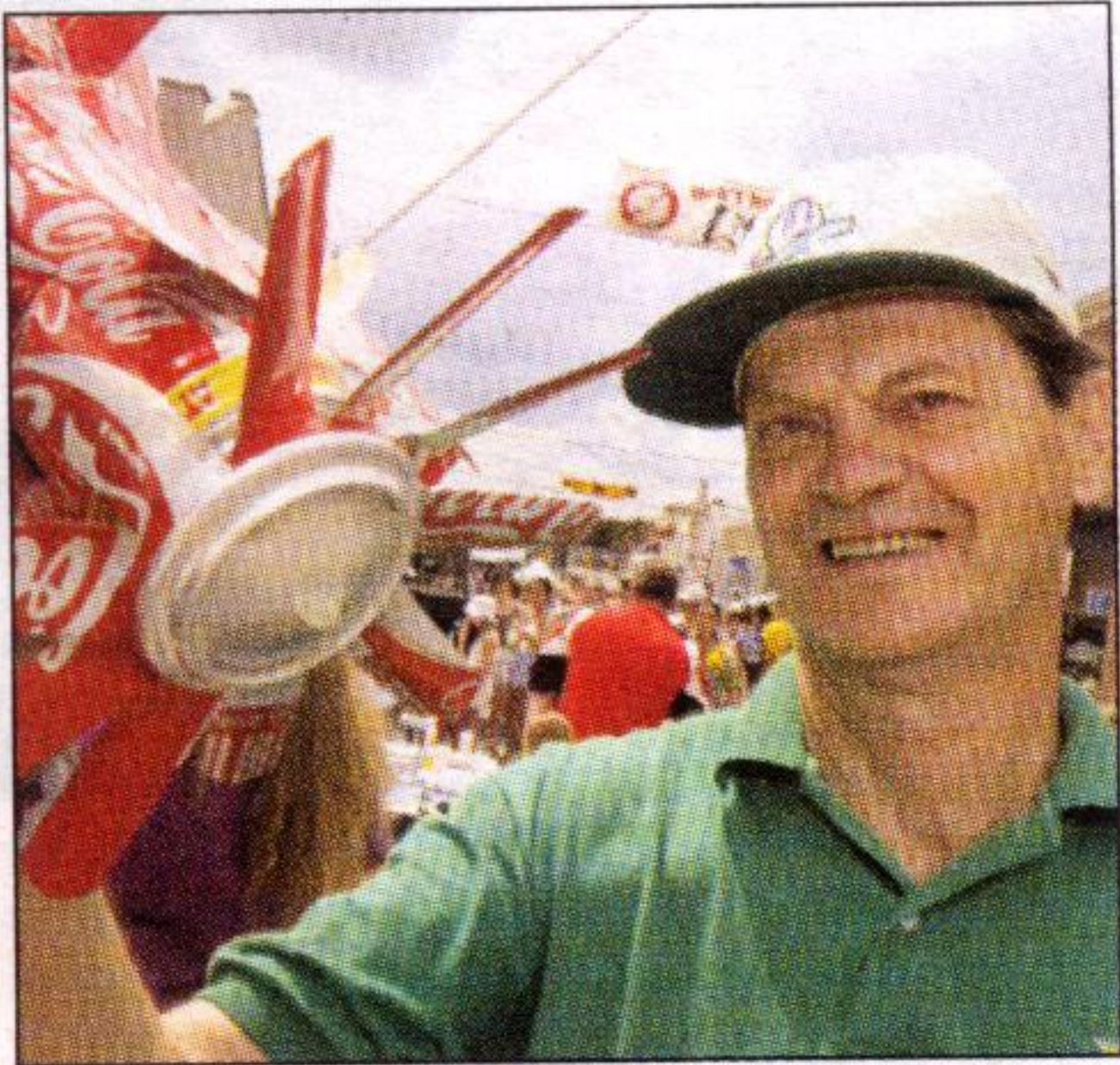
of volunteers.
