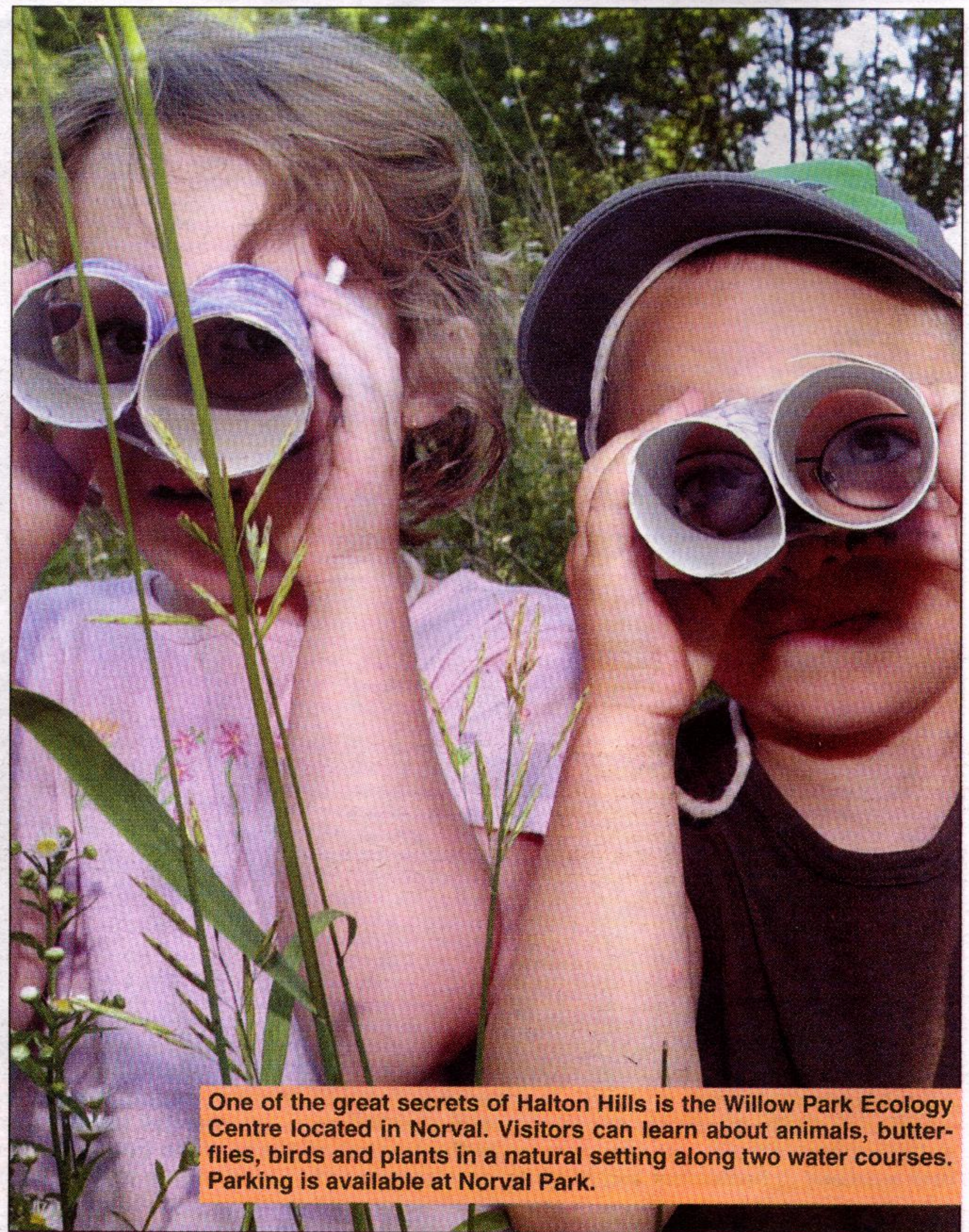

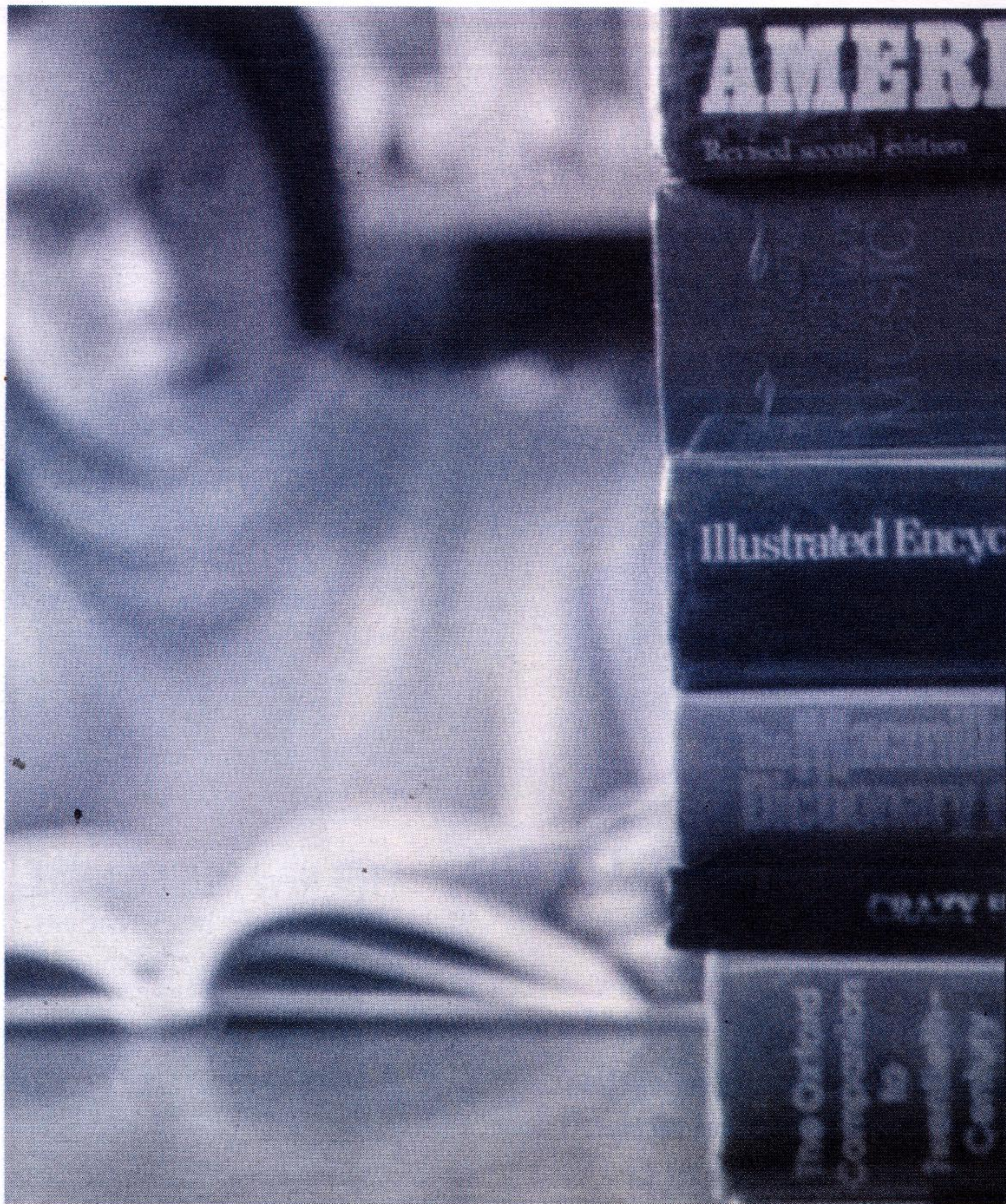
Before (1985)
