Starting January 1, 2004, every Canadian business retailer, manufacturer, home-based— will have to comply with federal privacy laws. Businesses will be required to protect the personal information of their customers, employees, members and others who have provided data. Companies will be required to put into place policies and systems to manage the collection, use and dissemination of such personal information.
