Hearing for controversial quarry expansion begins

Dufferin wants to expand by 83 hectares its 486hectare quarry operation— Canada's largest quarry site— which straddles the Halton Hills-Milton border.

It will provide for the total extraction of 52 million tonnes of stone, starting in 2007, and feeding a lot of growth-related projects happening in Greater Toronto. The approval would take the quarry's life span from its current eight years to between 18 and 20 years.

Halton Region, the Niagara Escarpment Commission, and Milton and Halton Hills town councils have given the green light for the proposal.

Under an agreement set out by the lead decisionmaker, the region, Conservation Halton would monitor an intricate recharge system created by Dufferin to fill the two quarries with water once they've been exhausted of aggregate.

Also, Dufferin would have to agree to a complex environmental protection plan of legal checks and balances that would monitor the quality of the groundwater and its impact on wetlands that surround the site.







LIVING WITH A LOSS OF HEARING

Some voices are easier to understand than others. The clearly speaking person pronounces words that are more precisely formed, or articulated. The rate of speed of words spoken also effects our ability to understand.

If one can see the speaker as he/she is talking, this makes it easier to understand. The environment also has an affect on speech understanding - bare walls and floors in a room causes sound to "bounce" around. Keep in mind that it is much easier to converse in a quiet carpeted room.

Make sure that there is good lighting and try to maintain a speaking distance of less than nine feet. You'll be pleasantly surprised at how much easier conversation

Hearing loss can dampen enjoyment of movies, music, church services, watching TV, eating out, and talking on the telephone. Even a mild hearing loss can reduce your quality of life.
