That same night, another home on Winston Churchill Blvd. was entered through an unlocked rear door. Money was also taken from a purse in that incident.

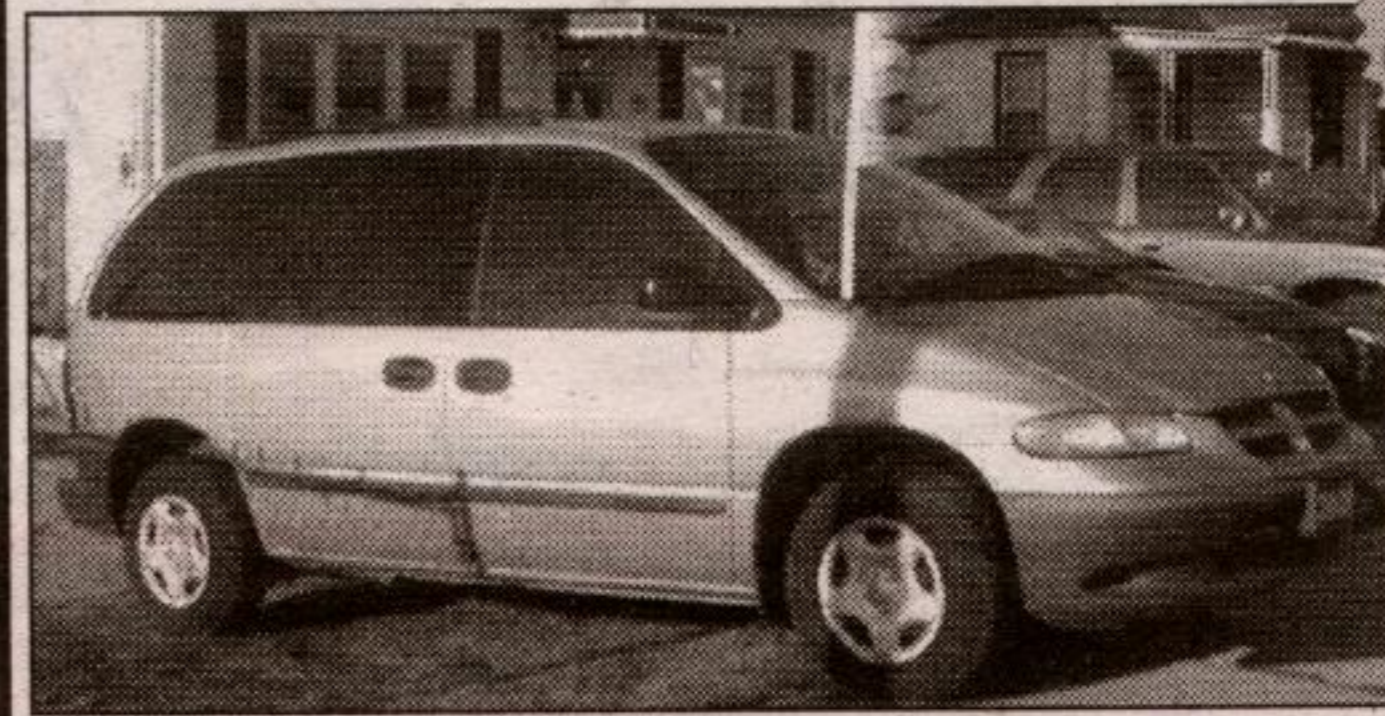

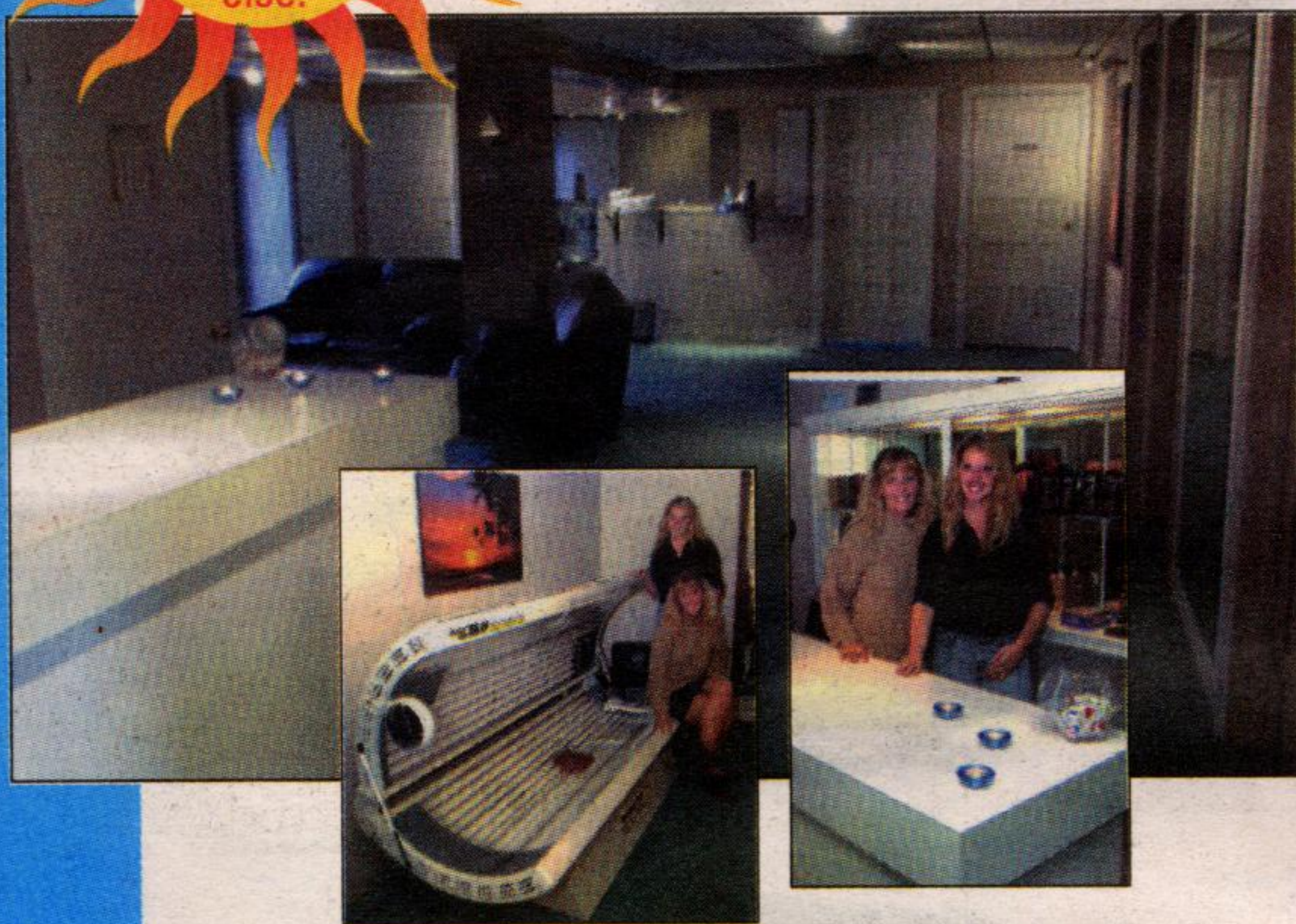
