## Raiders, Derbys draw 2-2

The Streetsville Derbys may not even make the playoffs this season. And if they don't, the Georgetown Raiders certainly won't miss them.

The Derbys, currently ninth in the Provincial Jr. A Hockey League's West Conference, stole a point from the Raiders for the second time this season Tuesday night. Streetsville weathered a 17-shot barrage in the final period to earn a 2-2 tie with Georgetown, now 23-1-2 on the year.

Tyson Gimblett and Tyler Leggo gave the Raiders a 2-0 first-period lead but Streetsville scored twice in the second to even the score. In the third, the Raiders outshot Streetsville 17-6 but could not beat Tudor Petkov.

With 48 points, the Raiders have an eight-point lead over second-place Oakville. The Raiders play in Bramalea Friday and host Burlington Saturday. Game time is 7:30 p.m. at Alcott Arena.

### SIDEWALK SNOW CLEARING SERVICES

Halton Hills Council adopted a sidewalk snow clearing policy and only Town staff or their designated contractor clear the areas identified in the policy. As a courtesy to all residences we do ask that homeowners clear the sidewalk in front of their houses. This provides for safer conditions for children and adults alike as they no longer have to traverse through deep snow and ice and do not have to use the road while walking.

Sidewalks receiving snow clearing services are on both sides of collector and arterial highways, sidewalks on roads with greater than 1000 AADT, and sidewalks in walkways that connect to sidewalks on collector and arterial highways. The following roads are scheduled for sidewalk clearing.
