A lesson in carpet choices

o assist you in choosing the best carpet for your home, not only I should you consider style, texture and colour, but you will want to compare the features and benefits of the various types of carpets and common fibres.

Carpet is a major purchase and its performance (how long it retains its like-new appearance) will relate to what you buy and how you use it. Consider where the carpet is to be installed; ask yourself questions such as: Is it a high-traffic area? Is there direct assess to the room from the outside? Is this an activity centre for children and pets in the home? Will the carpet be in the path of direct sunlight? Is there likely to be dampness at floor level?

The combination of carpet fibre and construction play a big role in performance characteristics. Consider the features and benefits of the different carpet fibre options when deciding which is best for you:

Nylon is the most popular, most wearresistant, resilient and durable carpet fibre. Nylon has an ability to resist soiling, offers great colour options and usually has been treated for stain resistance. Resulting from the latest manufacturing technology, new soft nylons have been recently introduced in the market.

Polyester is noted for its superior stain resistance and for its luxurious softness to the touch when used in thick, cut-pile saxonies. Polyester is easily cleaned, has excellent colour clarity and retention and is perfect for bedrooms and low traffic areas.

Olefin (Polypropylene) is very affordable, strong, resists wear, static electricity, and provides superior stain resistance. Carpet made from this fibre is notably colourfast because the colour is added dur-

ing fibre production. Many Berbers are made from olefin fibre and are an economical choice for basement rooms, family rooms, kids' bedrooms, and home offices.

Wool, although less popular in North America than other parts of the world, more expensive and less soil/stain-resistant than the synthetic fibres, is noted for its softness,

bulk, luxury and performance. Besides the choice of fibre, the quality of carpet can be enhanced by the way the fibres or yarn is twisted, heat set, and by the density of the tufts in the construction. Pile height or ounce weight of a carpet may affect perception of quality but is really a matter of personal choice. These factors do not, in themselves, without construction consideration, affect durability. The density of the tufts refers to the amount of yarn in the carpet and the closeness of the tufts or loops; the denser, the better the durability. Twisting refers to the number of times a carpet tuft is twisted. Tightly twisted fibres are very durable and perform well in high traffic areas. Heat-setting is the process that sets the twist by heat or steam enabling prolonged resilience over time.
