



Fire damage \$10,000

Talton Hills firefighters were called to a house fire that resulted in \$10,000 damage to a Moore Park Cr. home.

Arriving crews found a house full of smoke and a fire in the wall surrounding the fireplace. Firefighters extinguished the blaze and removed ceiling tiles and brickwork from around the fireplace to see if the fire had spread.

The homeowner had been burning wood from an old fence in the fireplace and firefighters believe the fire was a result of the high heat generated from burning the fence, and exposure of a wood stud adjacent to the heat box of the fireplace.
