
Marc Laforet turned in a thirdplace finish in the 11-12 boys 200m freestyle. Laforet was also fifth in the 100m freestyle.


Nicole Abbott earned an eighthplace finish in the 11-12 girls 400m freestyle and was ninth in the 800m freestyle.






