George Fox to star at Norval Riverfest

Multi-award winning George Fox will be headlining the Riverfest 2004 concert on June 5 in Norval Park.

Fox has three Junos for Country Male Vocalist of the Year and has won the Canadian Country Music Awards and RPM Big Country Awards a combined total of eight times in his career.

Fox will be singing many of his old favourites plus some new tunes from his newly released album. His new CD, called *Canadian*, contains 12 new songs and is the culmination of years of writing, research and criss-crossing this country from Victoria to St. John's. Copies of Fox's new work will be available at Riverfest.

Riverfest is a celebration of the Credit River and the day includes a look into the life of the Credit, boat races, karate and tai chi demonstrations, art gallery exhibit and crafts and vendors.

Taking to the afternoon folk concert stage will be David Francey, Kirk & Magoo, James Gordon and Nonie Crete, plus the Brampton Folk Club will be holding an open stage at the St. Paul's Parish Hall and musicians of all ages and skill levels are invited to participate.

Francey and Gordon return to the Norval Park stage in the evening hours to serve as opening acts for Fox. For evening concert tickets, \$15, call 905-877-8533. Admission to the daytime festival is \$5 per person or \$10 per family.
