
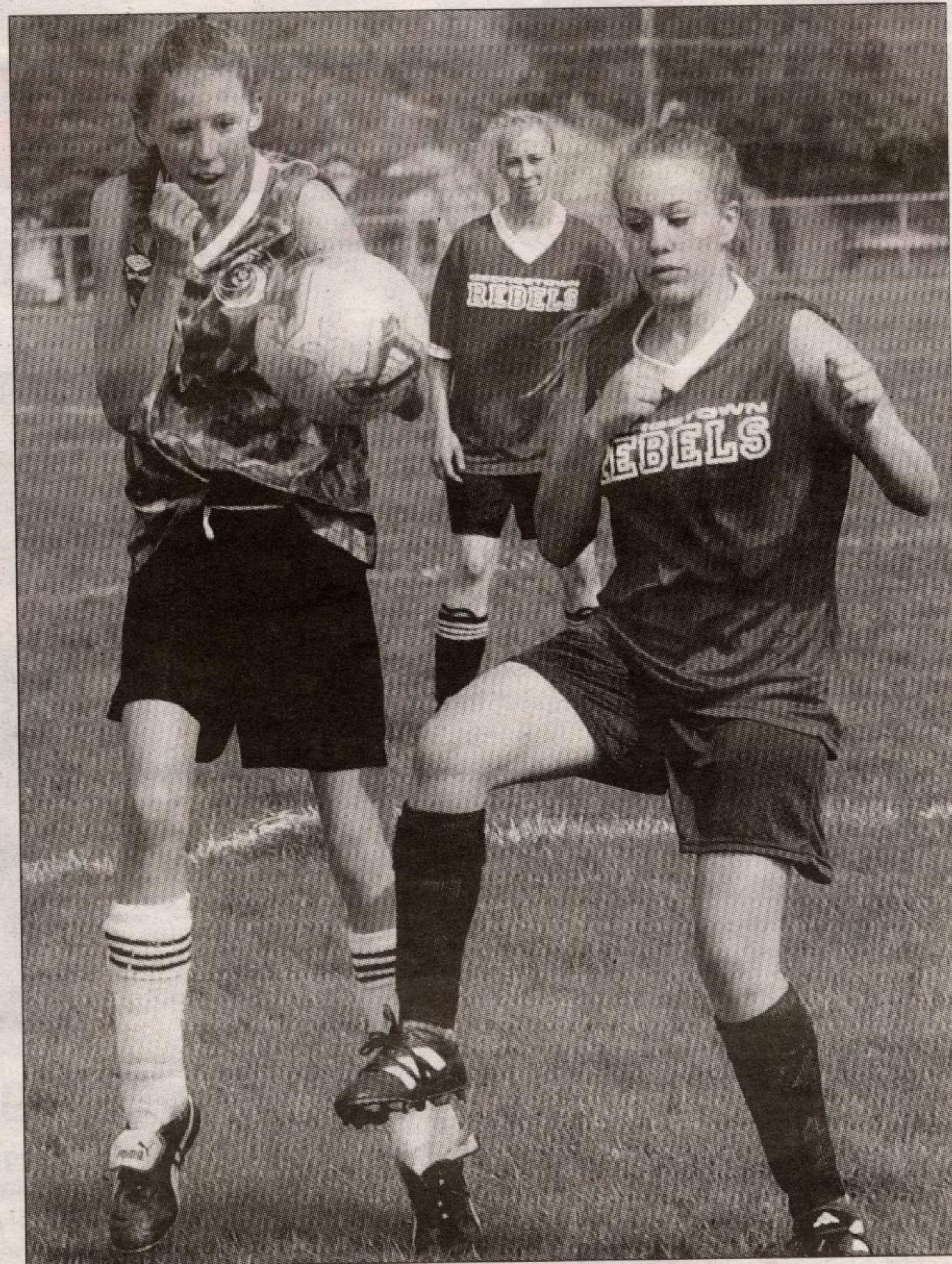
### WHITE WINE BASICS

White wine can actually be made from green, red or black grapes as all grape juice is initially colorless. with the exception of a few wines, however, most whites are made from green grapes. White wine should be served chilled but not ice cold, which can mask many flavours. White wine grape varieties are Chardonnay, Chenin blanc, Gerwurtz-traminer, Muscat, Riesling, Sauvignon blanc, Semillon, and Viognier (almost unheard of until recently), Gargaega (soave), Pinot Gris, Trebbiano, Verdicchio, Vidal.

**TRIVIA:**  
*As late as the 17th century French wine makers did not use corks. Instead they used oil-soaked rags stuffed into bottles.*

### Andrews places first... again

Kaitlyn Andrews picked up two more victories at the 28th Annual Hungerford-Kinsmen Invitational Track and Field Meet.

Andrews won both the junior girls shot put and discus at the meet which drew 38 high school teams from eastern Ontario, the GTA and the United States.

The Grade 10 student at Acton High School placed first in the shot put with a distance of 12.22m and took first in the discus with a throw of 35.22m. She was also second in the javelin with a throw of 28.77m.

Norm Tosh earned a third-place finish in the midget boys shot put with a put of 12.81m.

Jaimi Fellows was seventh in the midget girls high jump, clearing 1.35m. She was also 16th in the 80m hurdles.

Daniel Kearns was 10th in the midget boys shot put with a distance of 10.81m and 12th in discus.

Troy Ethier was 19th in both the senior boys long jump and triple jump and 21st in the 100m.
