Globe holds auditions for fall musical

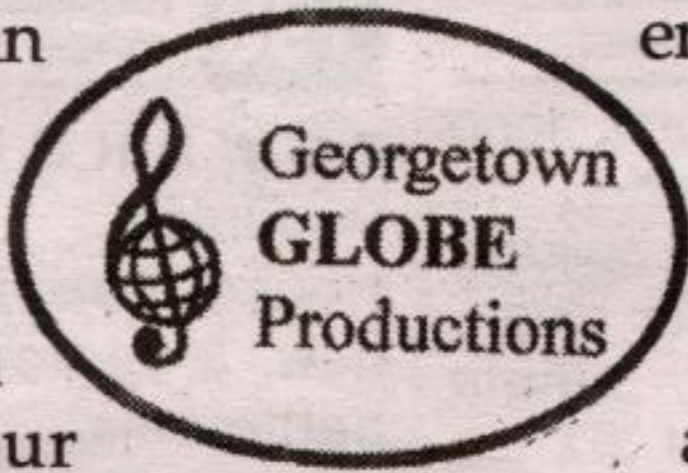
Auditions are being held on May 28 and 29 for Georgetown Globe Productions' *City of Angels*.
