Fire calls

House fire damage limited to \$5,000

Talton Hills firefighters were called to an Argyll Rd. home late Sunday evening. When they arrived they found the house full of smoke and smoke detectors sounding.

Investigation revealed that the homeowner's son, who was at home with friends when there was a power outage, had lit a candle and set it on a deacon's bench in the front hallway.

A short time late he went to a friend's home and when he returned he found the house full of smoke and the bench on fire.

He quickly took the bench out of the home and extinguished the fire.

Crews ventilated the home and checked to see if the fire had spread.

Fire damage, estimated at \$5,000, was contained to the bench and wall immediately behind it.
