Cres in Georgetown South starting at 8 a.m.


It promises to be a large event with each member selling their wares at the one location.

Team members are asking residents to save a trip to the beer store, and make empties available for pick-up by Heather's Heros to contribute to the cause.


Anyone can make a personal donation to any of the team members. Donation forms will be available at the garage sale, and also on hand on the bottle drive.


