

# Duathlon debut a winning one for local teen

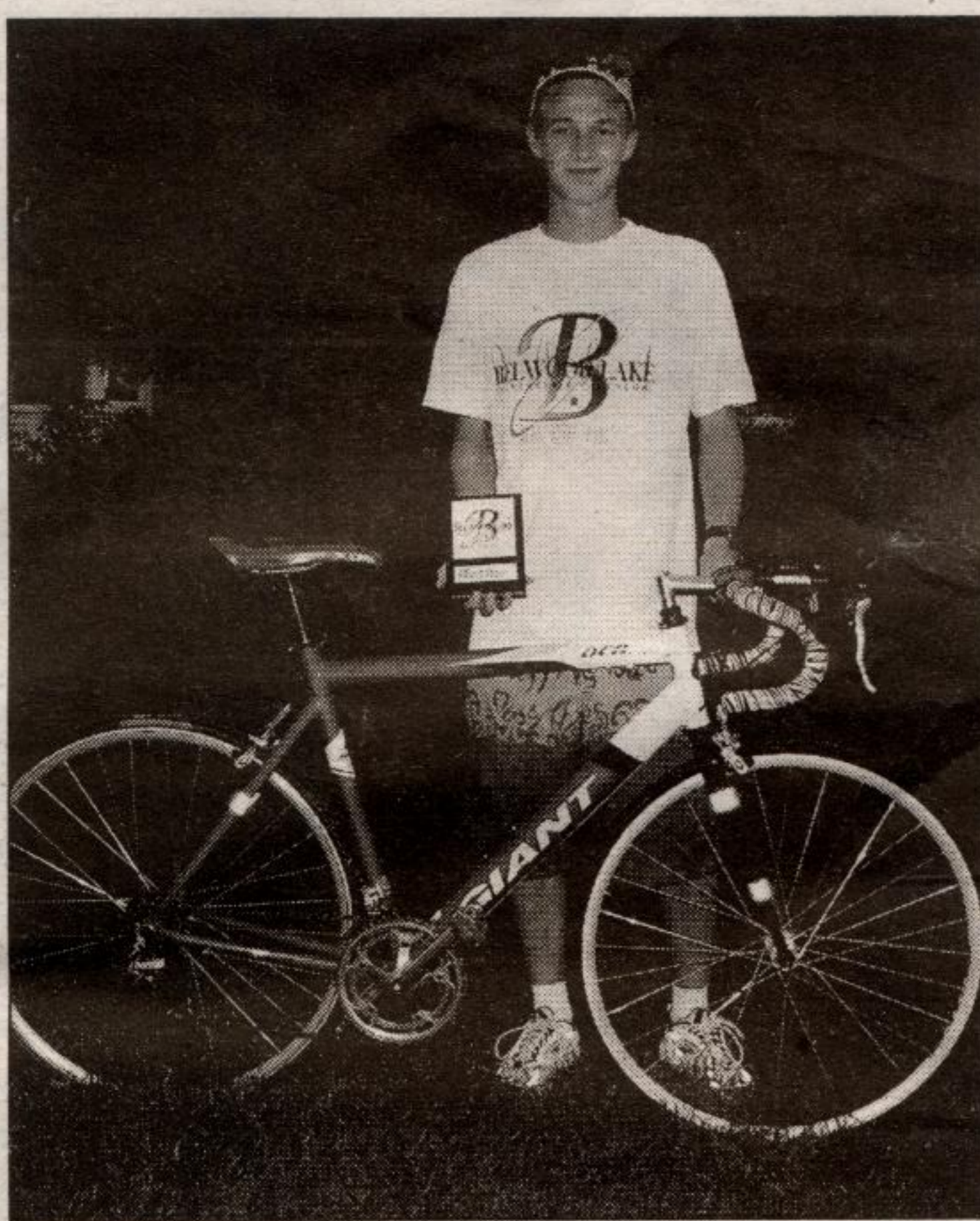
**G**eorgetown's Mike McGill made quite the duathlon debut.

The 17-year-old won his age class (19-and-under) and finished 15th overall out of 186 competitors at the Belwood Triathlon & Duathlon. The race, part of the Subaru Triathlon Series, was McGill's first duathlon.

McGill, a former Golden Horseshoe Athletic Conference (GHAC) cross-country champion, took full advantage of his running skills. He was fourth after the two-kilometre run to start the race, finishing in five minutes and 56 seconds.

Though being a newcomer to competitive cycling, McGill finished the 33-kilometre ride in under an hour, leaving him two minutes behind the leader in his age class, but still in striking distance.

He delivered in the race's final leg, a seven-kilometre run. He finished in 26 minutes and three seconds for the third-best overall time. That moved him into



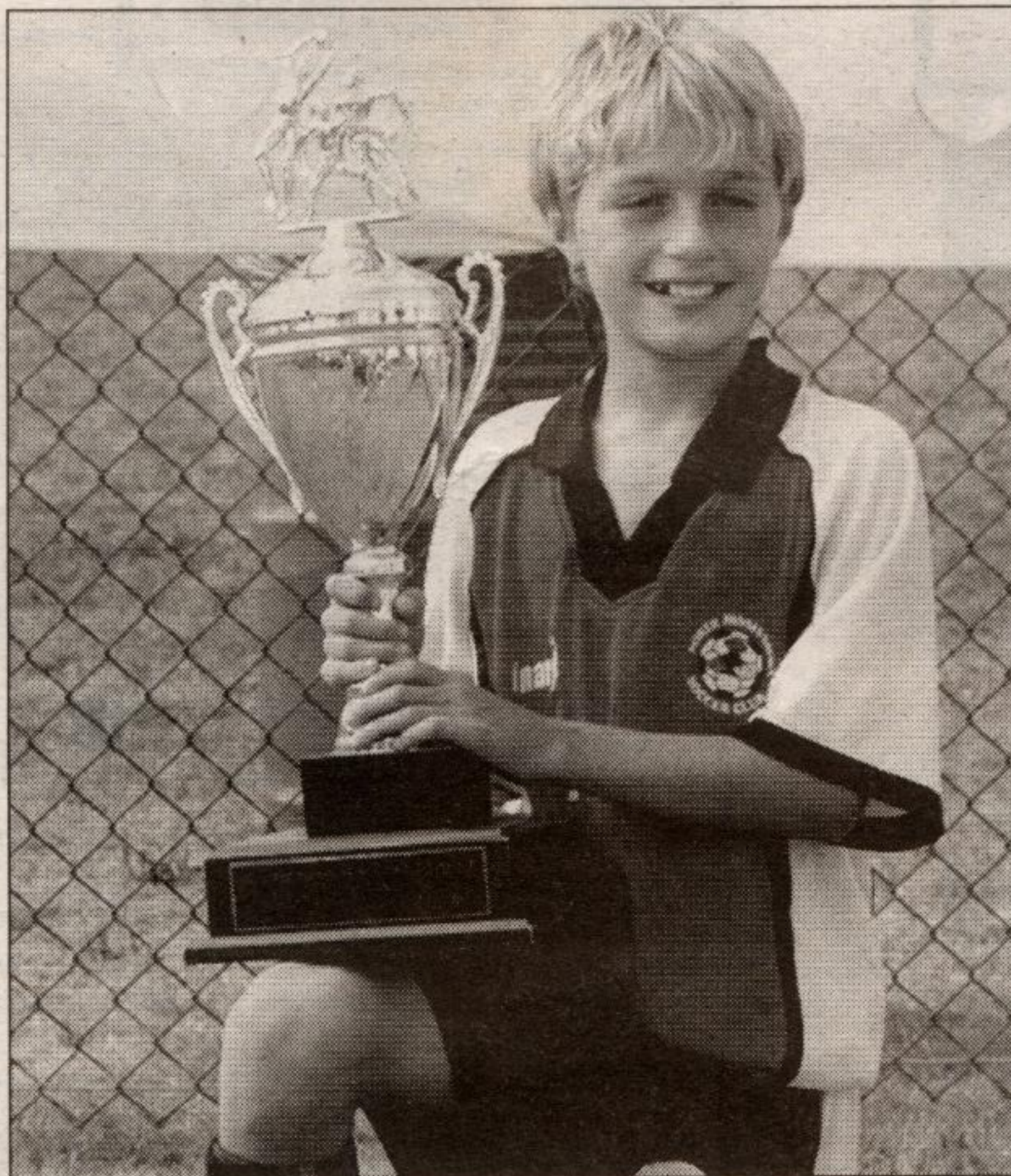

15th overall and his total time of one hour, 31 minutes and 28 seconds won his division by a minute and 24 seconds.

In the Belwood Triathlon, John Grace of Georgetown finished second in the men's 50-54 division and 70th overall in the field of 424 competitors. Grace finished with a strong run, placing 24th overall on the final leg by completing the seven kilometre run in 26 minutes, 37 seconds.

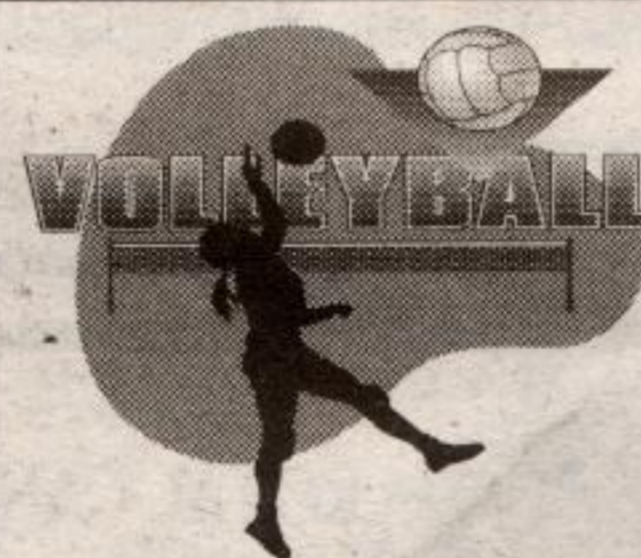
