# Driver hurt in River Road crash

A 27-year-old man was airlifted after his pickup truck rolled on River Drive Friday night. D/Cst. Anderson at 905-878-5511, ext. 5123.

The man was trapped inside the vehicle for nearly an hour after his truck landed on its roof in a farmer's field. Halton Hills Fire Department, Halton Ambulance and Halton Regional Police freed him from the truck and he was taken by air ambulance to hospital, suffering from several fractured ribs and internal injuries.

Halton Police did not report the man's hometown or the hospital he was taken to. The 2000 GMC pickup was traveling southwest on River Drive around 9 p.m. when it failed to negotiate a curve. It started to slide into oncoming traffic, continued across the road, struck several signs before going into a field on the east side of 10th Line and flipping onto its roof. Damage to the vehicle is set at \$25,000. No charges have been laid.

Police say Silver Creek Gas Bar on Hwy. 7 was broken into early Sunday morning. Suspects gained entry through a glass door but set off an alarm at 5:46 a.m. The owner saw a small grey car leaving the scene. Cigarettes were taken from the gas station.
