## Home spas are hot in any style


Thether they are used indoors or outdoors, spas and hot tubs provide year round fun, entertainment and relaxation in the privacy of your own home. When you decide to join the thousands of families across Canada already enjoying a relaxing soak in a hot tub, here are a few pointers to get you on your way.

Portable Hot Tubs— Available in a wide variety of whirlpool jet configurations and seating arrangements, these units feature an acrylic or composite shell and all the equipment enclosed in a finished cabinet. You can choose from sizes to fit from 2 to 8 people and available options include amenities such as built-in stereos and TV's, extra-powerful jets, special lighting and automated controls. Self-contained 'plug-and-play' design means that you can be relaxing in your own spa in no time.

Built-in Hot Tubs— Similar in style to portable units, the shell is built into a custom enclosure such as the deck of a patio or a special niche in a room. Once installed, these spas become a fixture of the house or a feature of your patio or pool.

Soft-sided Hot Tubs— Providing the ultimate in portability, soft-sided hot tubs feature soft foam walls covered by vinyl. Lightweight and small enough to fit in a pickup truck, these easy to set up spas are great for the cottage or the occasional user.

Wooden Hot Tubs— For purists, nothing can match the classic look of a wooden hot tub. Made from staves of



cedar or redwood, these tubs look wonderful in any setting and many units now come with liners to help extend their life.

Exercise Spas— The largest hot tub models available are exercise or swim spas. Ideal for those who want to maximize the use a hot tub for exercise, they feature a 'counter-current' jet at one end that, like a treadmill, allows bathers to swim while remaining in one spot in the water. These long, rectangular shells can be finished with a custom cabinet or can be set into a floor or deck.
