Debit card fraud cases in Acton could hit 100, says Halton detective

Talton Police have received approximately 60 reports of debit card fraud in the Acton area over the past couple of weeks.

Detective Sgt. Don Cousens said that the number of frauds could be as high as 100 because of incidents reported to the bank only.

The 'skimming' of debit cards is suspected to have

happened at a couple of locations in Acton.

Police are continuing their investigation but don't suspect there will be any more incidents due to the investigation.

An Acura Integra on Queen St. in Georgetown had its tires slashed and two vehicle emblems removed sometime between Friday and Monday. Damage is estimated at \$500.

Council shuffles items

Halton Hills council recently referred three items to other committees.

Councillor Clark Somerville requested a letter from the Acton BIA be referred to the Community Affairs committee for discussion on municipal assistance. The BIA was requesting town dollars to help beautify the downtown area.

Councillor Jane Fogal asked that a federal government program, EnerGuide, that requires municipal sponsorship, be referred to 2005 budget discussions. The program looks at energy efficiency for older and new homes.

Councillor Ron Chatten asked the 2005 budget discussions also include increased boulevard maintenance of Hwy. 7 along the Norval hill. The Ontario Ministry of Transportation, which is financially responsible for the boulevard, allows only two cuttings a year and only one swathe from the road.
