Financial assistance may be available for those who:

- Have a dental need
- Have difficulty paying for dental treatment and,

more of the following activities of daily living, getting in and out of bed and the shower, going up and down stairs.

Since 1998 the region has been working with the community to address the oral health needs of the frail elderly and adults with special needs through the Halton Oral Health Outreach program.

Halton's Oral Health Outreach committee is looking at making the Dental Care Counts program more accessible for low income adults.



Construction drawings showing the proposed work may be reviewed at the Planning & Public Works Department, Halton Regional Centre, 1151 Bronte Road, Oakville.


