McCarrol is no stranger to instructing successful dancers in the highland dance world. Since 1987, dancers in her group have won 17 trophies at the Canadians, and she has taken four dancers to the World Championships, including Donna and Darlene Downey, Lee McKeown and Megan Allan. Allan came home with a third place win in the 1995 world championships.

And if the past couple of years are any indication, Stephanie Wright will be one more World Champion added to the list.




