Ultra-light plane ends up in field Glen Williams pilot hurt in crash

A 68-year-old Glen Williams man remains in a Toronto hospital after his ultra-light plane crashed in field in Vaughan Sunday afternoon.

The man and a friend took off in separate ultra-lights from Hawksfield Airport in Oro, Ontario around 1:30 p.m. The two were flying to Brampton Airport but about an hour into their flight, the friend noticed the man's ultra-light circling and he did not respond to radio calls. Shortly after, the ultra-light crashed into a field on King Vaughan Road.

The friend landed nearby and called 911.

The injured man was airlifted to Sunnybrook Health Centre in Toronto in serious condition. He is currently listed in

stable condition with injuries to his legs.

The cause of the crash has been determined as accidental with mechanical failure suspected. It is no longer under investigation.

The name of the injured man has not been released.

Ontario's new free vaccines will protect kids

The government of Ontario is helping kids stay safe from **chicken pox** and **meningococcal meningitis**, and helping families by adding these free vaccinations to the routine immunization schedule. Here's how it works:

- Vaccines for chicken pox and meningococcal meningitis are now available for one-year-old children in Ontario born on or after September 1, 2003.
- Starting in January 2005, 5-year-olds who haven't had chicken pox can also get the vaccine, as well as high-risk people of any age.
- Also starting in January 2005, 12-year-olds, 15- to 19-year-olds and high-risk people of any age will be eligible for free meningococcal meningitis vaccinations.
