

One Act Play Festival grooms new talent

hursday night, John Elliott Theatre came alive as Georgetown Little Theatre opened its fourth annual One Act Play Festival.

Opening with To Fly, a group of young actors, under the direction of Cat Heaven, portrayed students struggling with a school literature project in which they must create a play without props. As they argue amongst themselves, they finally settle on their parts, which involves them representing animals. The play reminds one of the story of creation, as the youths utilize building a human pyramid to illustrate the story. The well-executed play had one small flaw— the actors' voices were overpowered by the background music, which featured North American aboriginal sounds.

No Means No! is a powerful drama dealing with date rape, and features a cast of 22 teens directed by JQ Smith. Melissa (Tess Barao) has a crush on Rick (Evan Smith) and decides to pass on a movie night with best friend Jennie (Stacey Feggans) to attend a school dance, where she knows Rick will be attending. After a slow dance, a drunk Rick suggests he and Melissa go outside 'for some air' where he pulls her into the bushes and forces himself upon her. Her friend Dave (Chris Passmore) witnesses the act but is powerless to do anything as he froze. The next day, Rick brags to friends how Melissa was "all over him" and the kids feed the rumour mill. Dave is over-wrought with guilt


