An Evening with The Stars

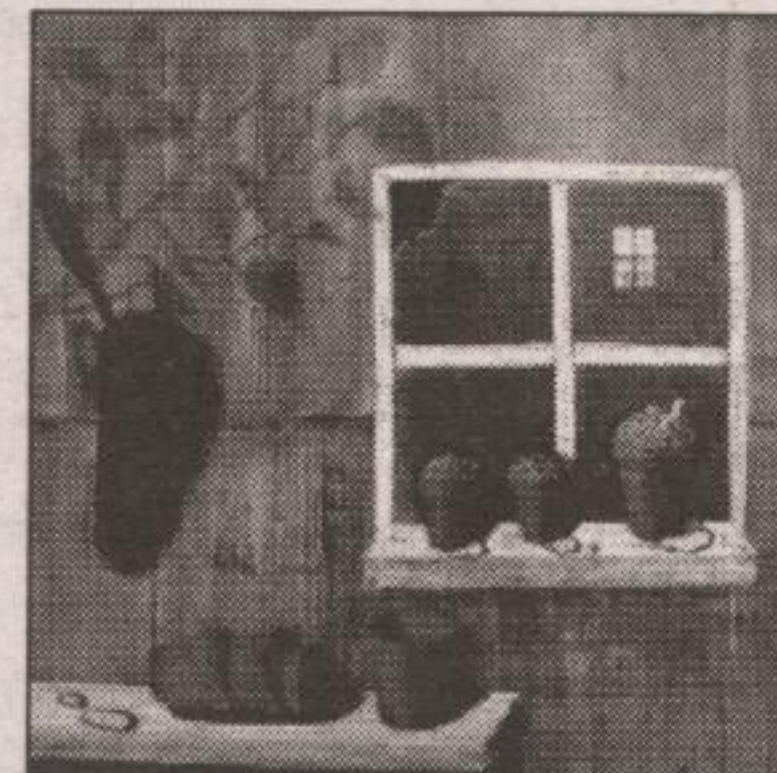

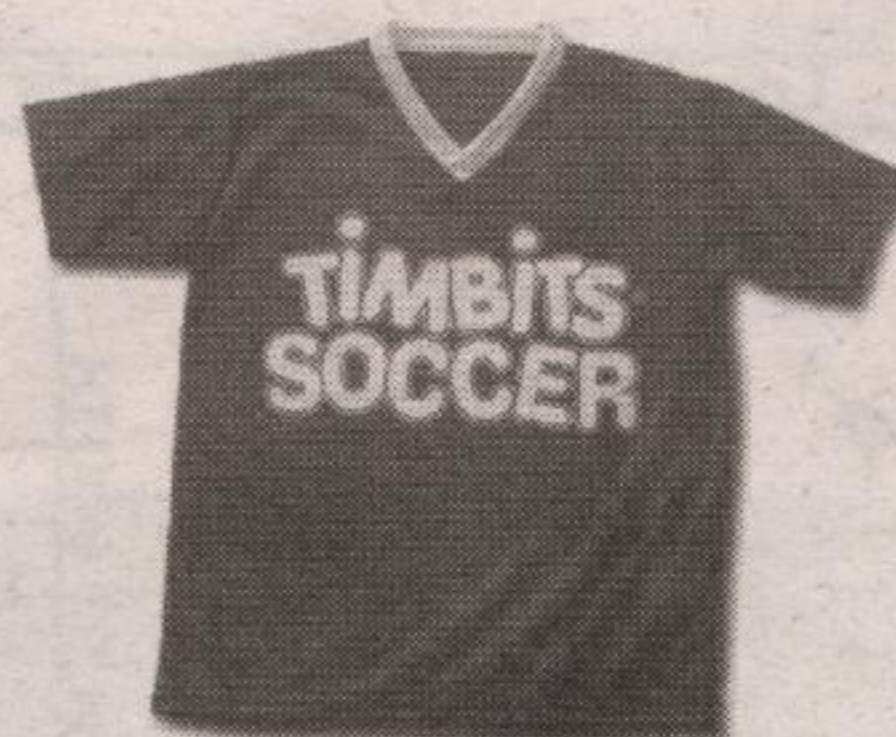
