

Ginger Peach Muffins



Ingredients

• 1 cup sugar

• 3 tbsp grated ginger root

• 1 tbsp grated lemon zest (approximately one lemon)

• 1/2 cup unsalted butter, softened

• 2 eggs, room temperature

• 1 cup buttermilk

• 2 cups flour

3/4 tsp baking soda

• 1/2 tsp salt

• 1 cup chopped fresh or frozen peaches

Method

1. Heat 1/4 cup of the sugar and ginger root in a small sauce pan over medium heat, stirring until the sugar is dissolved. Cool. Stir in the lemon zest and set aside.

2. Cream the butter and remaining 3/4 cups sugar in a bowl until well mixed. Add the eggs and beat well. Add the buttermilk and mix until combined

3. Combine the flour, baking soda and salt in a bowl.

4. Add the flour mixture to the butter mixture. Stir until just combined. Fold in the ginger mixture and peaches.

5. Spoon the batter into 12 greased muf-

fin cups, filling 3/4 full.

6. Bake at 375 degrees F. for 20-25 minutes or until golden brown.
