Camera Club holds two-day photo contest

Once again, Halton Hills Camera Club is organizing Capture the Hills 2004, October 2-3, a two-day photo competition in which amateur photographers comb the Halton Hills area, shooting anything that catches their eye. The contest is limited to 60 non-professional photographers.

The entry fee is \$25 and includes one roll of ISO 200 24 exposure film with processing. All pictures must be taken on the film provided and within the competition boundaries of Halton Hills. A map will be provided.

The registration deadline is October 2 at noon, but shooting can begin at 6:30 a.m. for those who are pre-registered.

After shooting for the two days, the film must be returned to the drop box at Halton Camera Exchange at 130 Guelph Street, before 10 p.m. October 3.

Participants can pick up their processed prints October 8-9, and

have until October 15 to select and enter their prints for judging.

Entrants may enter a maximum of six prints with no more than two per category, and must be submitted by the October 15 deadline to be judged by a panel of qualified judges. Photographers must also submit signed model releases for all images of people.

Categories include People, Creatures & Critters, Scenery and Architecture, and Foliage and Flowers.

The Junior Category is open to persons 13 and under and the entry fee is \$10. Parental consent is required. There are two divisions in the Junior Category, one for ages 7 and under, and another for ages 8 to 13.



Prizes will be awarded for first, second and third place winner in each category as determined by a special panel of judges. Halton Hills Mayor Rick Bonnette will also select the Mayor's Choice for a special award.

Winning photos will be unveiled and prizes will be awarded at the Halton Hills Civic Centre, Recreation Department, on Thursday, October 28 at 7:30 p.m. A preview of all submitted entries will commence at 6:30 p.m.
