

# Seniors Centre president suggests A&P as location for new community centre

The president of the Georgetown Seniors Centre suggested the Town consider the A&P grocery store as the future location of the Georgetown library, the Georgetown Seniors Centre and a Georgetown's Open Door youth centre.

Ted Thompson said the timing is right for the Town to consider this plan "at this moment in time". He presented the idea at the Sept. 13 council meeting.

All three organizations are on the lookout for new locations that can provide larger accommodations, prefer-

ably in a central place in Georgetown.

The seniors' centre is being considered for the second phase of the Gellert Centre in Georgetown South, but Thompson said, without public transit or private vehicles, seniors would find its distance from the centre of town difficult to traverse economically.

A&P is slated to move to Georgetown South when a proposed plaza with a grocery store is built on Mountainview Rd. at Argyll Rd. likely sometime in the next couple of years.

Thompson suggested that the Sinclair Ave./Guelph St. building be

subdivided with the library using the downstairs and the seniors and the youth centres sharing the upstairs.

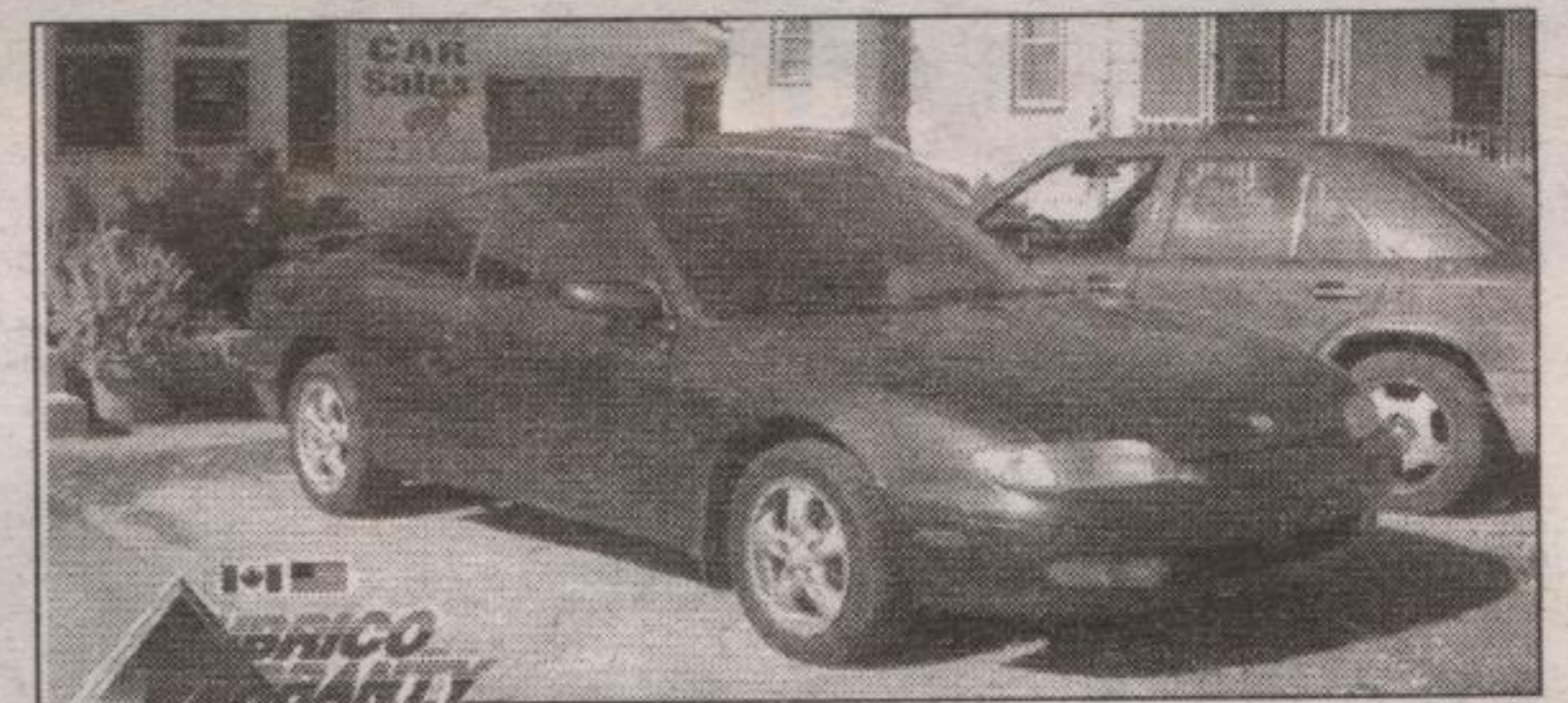
"It could serve the needs of the town in providing a central social centre, which would provide for the needs of the whole population in one building," Thompson said.

Councillor Jane Fogal called it an interesting idea and Mayor Rick Bonnette suggested it be referred to staff for future discussions and report back. Council supported that suggestion.

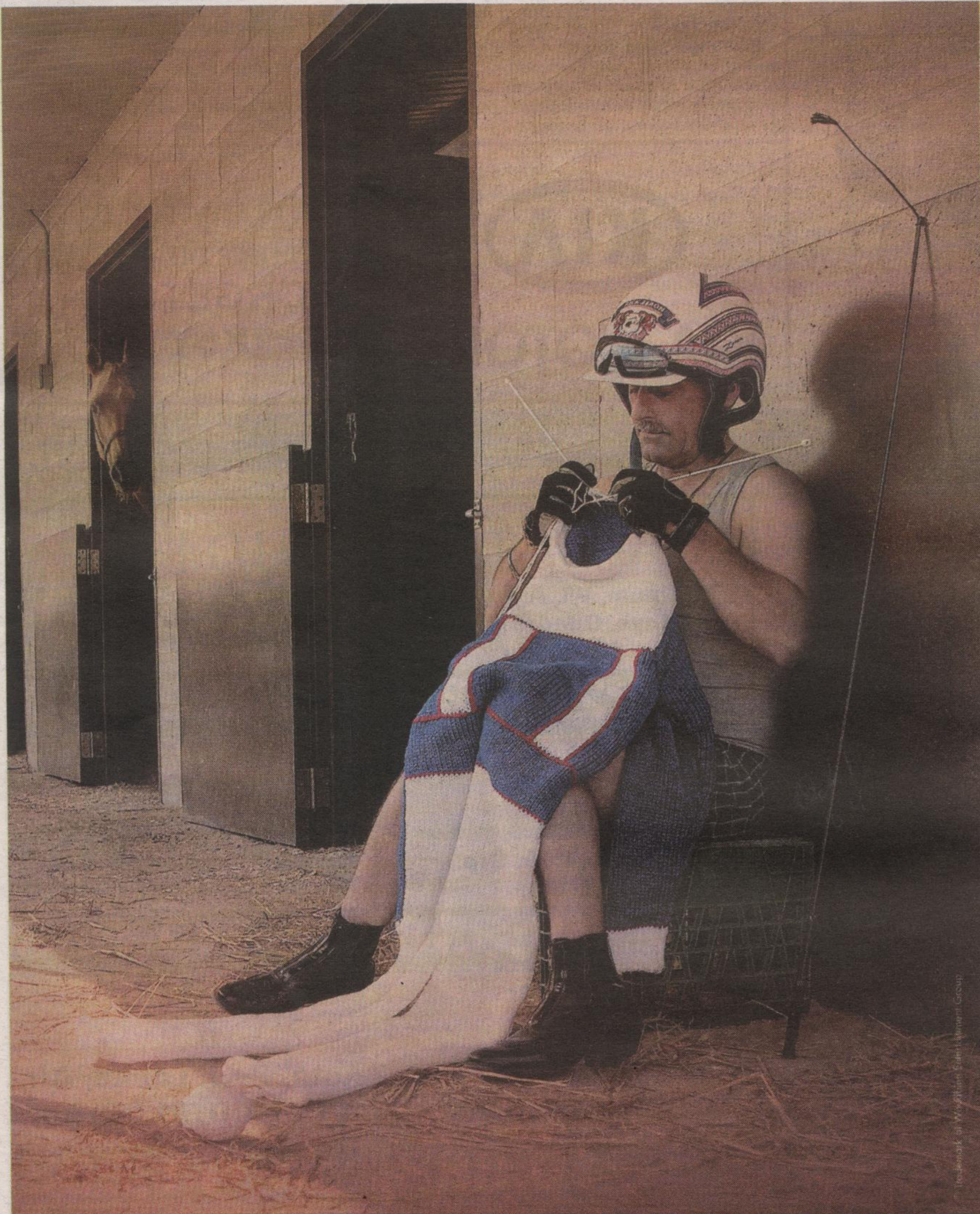
