

# Halton Region offers private well water information sessions this month

As part of Halton Region Health Department's ongoing initiative to promote well water safety, two well water information sessions for Halton residents on private well systems are scheduled for:

- Thursday, Oct. 7, at Stewarttown Public School, 15 Sideroad, Georgetown
- Thursday, Oct. 14, Campbellville Lion's Hall, 42 Guelph Line, Campbellville.

Residents can drop in anytime between 3-9 p.m. at either location.

The session will offer residents the opportunity to:

- Talk to public health inspectors about well water quality concerns;
- Have well water tested for nitrate (bring one cup of water in a sterilized jar);
- Drop off water samples in the approved

sample bottles, supplied by Halton Region's Health Department, to be sent away for bacteria testing;

- Pick up sterile water sampling bottles, for testing bacteria on a regular basis;
- Learn about water treatment systems that can correct water problems from local companies;
- Talk to professional well drillers from the Ontario Ground Water Association;
- Talk to staff from Halton Region's Planning and Public Works Department to discuss water conservation principles;
- Review well water records from Halton Region's well record database;
- Get familiar with the public health laboratory's phone-in system to retrieve water sample results;
- Receive a guide to caring for and protecting

their well and family's health.

Residents can drop water samples off at any water sample depots in Halton, Monday through Thursday, between 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. including Georgetown's Health Department Office, 93 Main Street.

The well water information sessions are offered in the spring and fall to help support residents who use private well water supplies. To preserve a safe well water supply, it is crucial for residents to maintain and repair their well and submit water samples at least three times a year to the Health Department for bacteria testing.

Water sample testing is free and consultations with public health inspectors are always available.

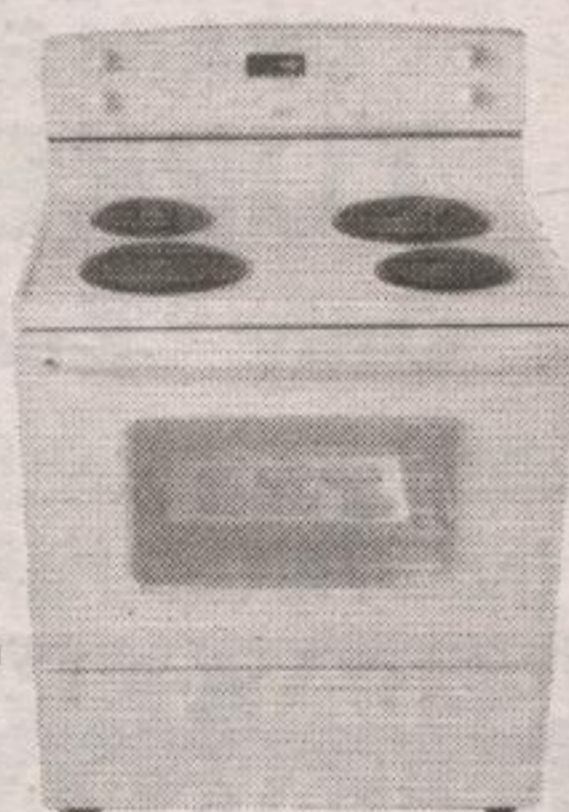

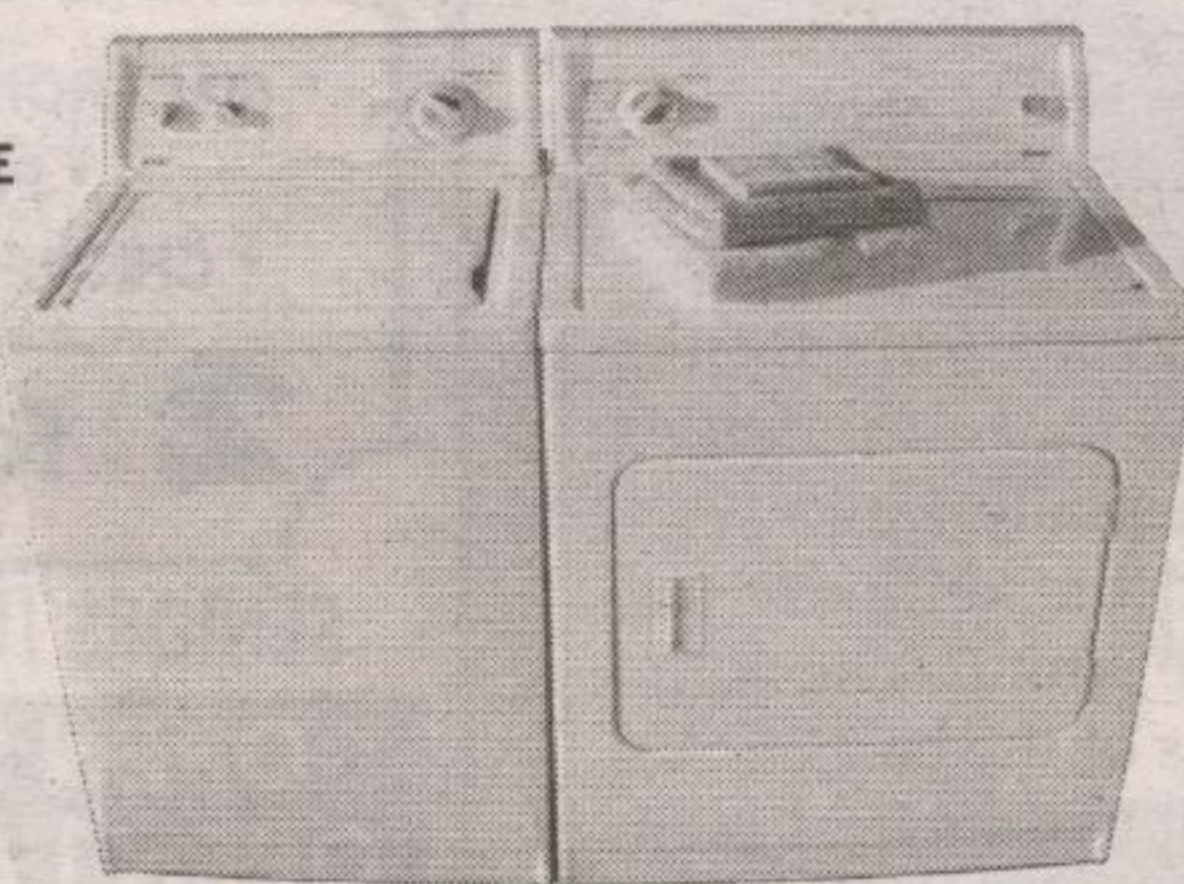

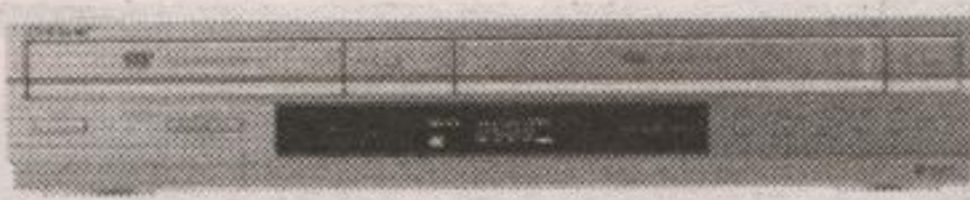

Fernbrook Homes wishes to locate a Sewage Pump Station on Town owned lands located in Georgetown South in order to accommodate servicing requirements for the development of the Georgetown South area between Mountainview Road and the Eighth Line (Main Street), north of Regional Road 10 (Ten Side Road). To facilitate this connection, Fernbrook Homes has approached the Town with a request to locate a Regional Sewage Pump Station on Town-owned open space land.

The proposed pump station will be owned and operated by the Region of Halton and will accommodate needs for both residential development planned for the area, the Gellert Community Centre and a future Public Secondary School site. There are no environmental constraints on this area of the Town open space system.

This Public Information Centre will provide you with an opportunity to review the project drawings and to discuss the proposed works with representatives from the Regional Municipality of Halton, Sernas Associates, the Project Consulting Engineer and the Town of Halton Hills.
