# Local musicians urged to submit work to unique Canadian CD compilation

ig Your Roots is a national compila-tion CD being released through the non-profit National Campus Radio Association (NCRA) early next year. The NCRA represents campus and community radio stations across the country, and uses that platform to promote new, independent music through Dig Your Roots.

It is a non-profit venture with the sole goal of promoting independent Canadian music.

"You can play traditional folk, bluegrass, blues, alternative country— the definition of roots is wide-ranging," explained the Ontario regional co-ordinator of the project, Chris Laursen. Laursen was program director at Carleton University's CKCU Radio in Ottawa which is well-known for its roots music programs. "What we are trying to do through Dig Your Roots is give artists who may have released a CD or two independently, or not even released

their own CD yet, a platform for their music. We especially want music from outside of major Canadian cities to be represented on the CD."

Twenty artists will be chosen by a jury in Ontario as finalists, and all of them will be promoted on the project's website, www.digyourroots.ca. Of those 20, three will be chosen by a national jury, along with 12 other artists from the rest of the country, to appear on the compilation CD.

If you're an artist who would like to submit your work, all you need to do is put three of your songs on a CD with a bio and photo and send it to Dig Your Roots, 2053 rue Jeanne d'Arc #220, Montreal, Quebec, H1W 3V3. Submissions must be postmarked by October 21. Full submission guidelines and an entry form can be obtained via the Dig Your Roots website. 
