The Georgetown Bach Chorale is offering choral, orchestral and solo classical concerts from now until the first week of May. The Chorale's concerts offer a unique combination of choral, orchestral and solo works, giving its audiences the opportunity to experience and enjoy a wide range of classical music.

Over the course of this season's concerts the Chorale will perform Handel's ever popular Messiah. This will be an unusual Messiah, intimate in scale, in the baroque style, and more delicate than today's audiences are accustomed to. New this year, the choir will be singing in baroque pitch in keeping with the baroque style of its repertoire.

The Chorale will also host three chamber concerts, two instrumental and one for piano and voice.


Starting with a chamber concert on Oct. 30, 8 p.m. in the Halton Hills Cultural Centre, the Chorale presents a

performance for violin and piano. Last year's audience will be familiar with violinist Michael Schulte. He will reprise his virtuoso performance with a selection of music sure to entrance those who love the violin. Accompanying him will be the Georgetown Bach Chorale's artistic director Ronald Greidanus on piano. The two will play pieces by Vitali, Greig, Liszt and Schubert. Tickets are

At the Advent Concert the choir will perform the first part of Handel's Messiah and the Hallelujah Chorus. Accompanying the Chorale will be an eight-piece baroque orchestra featuring Norman Engel, one of Canada's premiere baroque trumpet players. The choir will also sing the Advent Cantata No. 70 by J.S. Bach and the orchestra will perform Telemann's Trumpet Concerto in D major.

This concert will be held on Saturday, Nov. 27 at 8 p.m. at Knox Presbyterian Church, Georgetown, and Sunday, Nov. 28 at 3 p.m. at St. James Anglican Church, Caledon East as part of the Caledon East Chamber Series. Tickets are \$25.

Christmas will see the Chorale performing again at 157 Main St. S. in Georgetown. Attending these Christmas concerts is becoming a "must" for Georgetown music lovers. Combining period carols with selected readings and accompanied by harpsichord and


