## Source of the Song 3

### Songwriter Madole to host concert at Glen Williams hall

**B**rampton songwriter Bruce Madole will be hosting the Source of the Song 3 concert on Saturday, Nov. 6, 2-5 pm at the Glen Williams Town Hall.

For this event he welcomes three of Canada's leading folk artists as his special guests: the legendary folk artist Alex Sinclair (four solo CDs and 12 CDs with the group Tamarack), singer/songwriter Katherine Wheatley, and the award-winning guitarist/songwriter Wendell Ferguson.

The concert format consists of an acoustic "writer's round", in which songwriters take turns performing their own songs in an intimate, coffee-house style room.

"Our little posters always talk about the magic of original songs, and that's what it is "just totally magical," says Madole. "There's always a special charge that people get when they can hear songs performed by the people who wrote them.

"The Glen Williams Town Hall is a beautiful venue for listening to music, both

charming and intimate," says Madole.

"My wife Marlene has a painting studio at the Williams Mill there, in Studio 7, which is why we chose to do the concerts here in the Glen in the first place, just to draw attention to the tremendous arts community there. With the Williams Mill and Best's Harbour both being just steps away, arts and music lovers can make a day of it. I always suggest lunch at the Glen Oven Bakery, there's shopping in the Glen for fine arts and crafts, and then an early afternoon concert to round out the afternoon."

Tickets for the event are \$12 in advance and \$15 at the door. They are available at Studio 7, the Williams Mill Creative Arts Studios, 515 Main Street in Glen Williams (see www.williamsmill.com for directions), or from Best's Harbour, 523 Main Street (directions at www.bestsharbour.com).
