

Tips for Kids

 NEVER give anyone personal information, especially your address, phone number, or where you go to school

 NEVER agree to meet anyone whom you have "talked to" on-line without checking with your parents

NEVER send anyone your picture

 NEVER respond to any messages that make you feel uncomfortable. Tell your parents

 NEVER send rude or insulting messages

There are websites for parents to find out about computers and the Internet. Take the time to learn and be informed, to ensure your child's safety.

Tips for Parents

 Know what your child is doing on the Internet.

• Install computer-monitoring software so that you will know the websites and chat rooms that they are visiting, and the e-mail messages that your child is sending.
