"It's our chance to give back to our community," says Lois Fraser, Fraser Direct president. "We are grateful to the community for coming to the sale to help us support these worthy organizations."

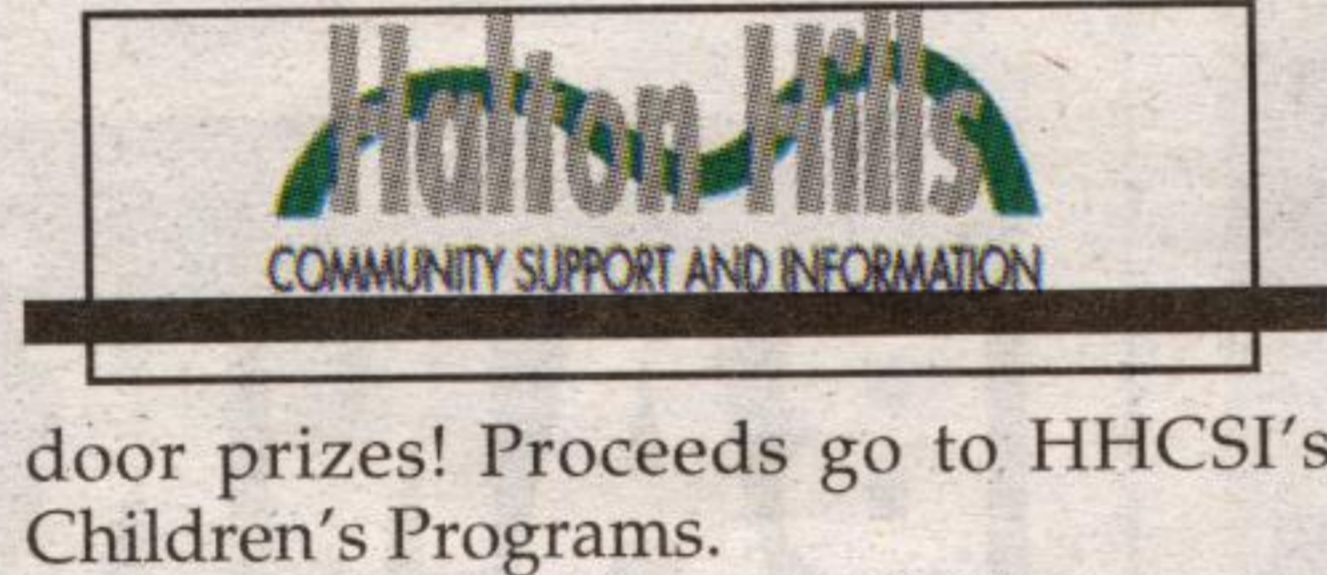
