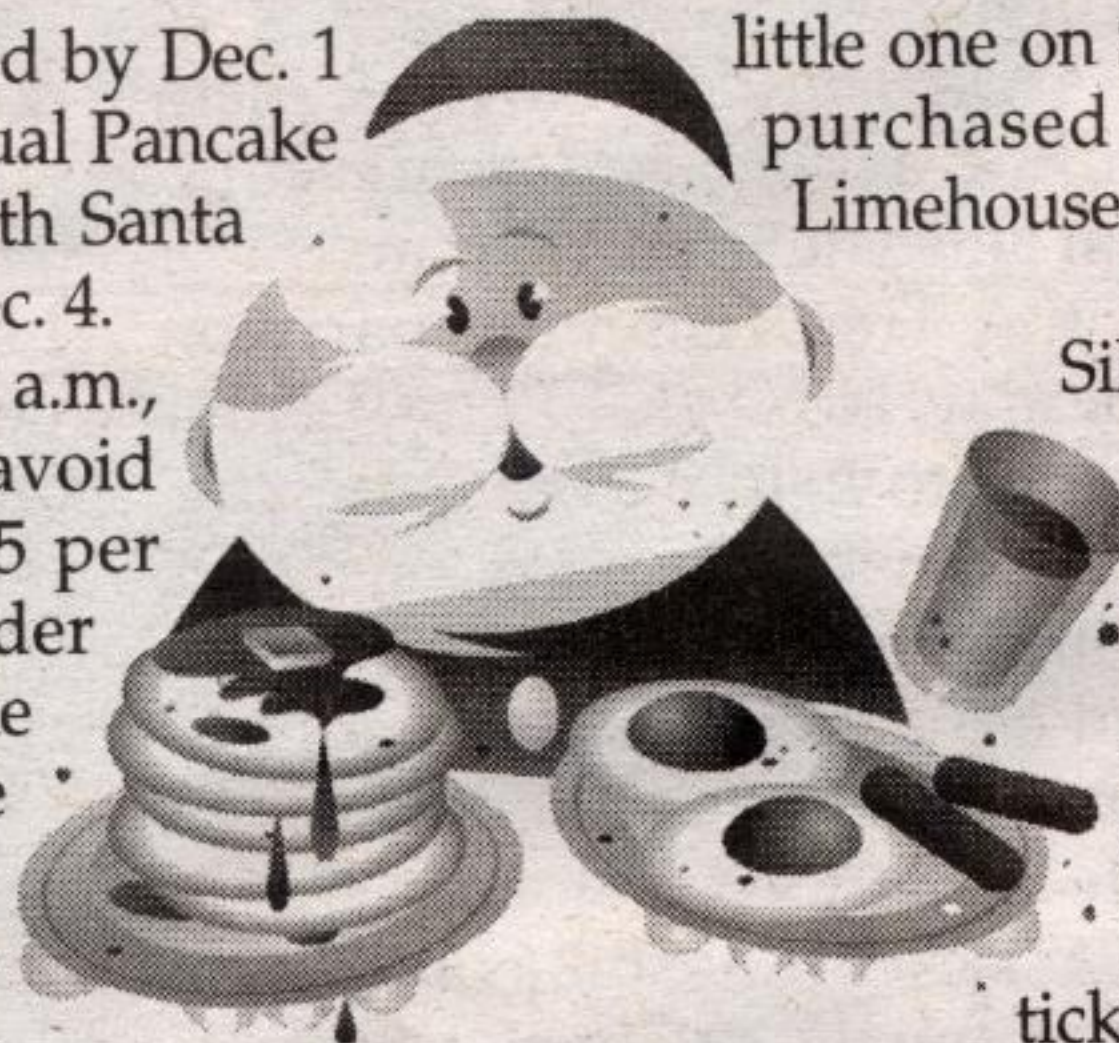


Have breakfast with Santa Claus
