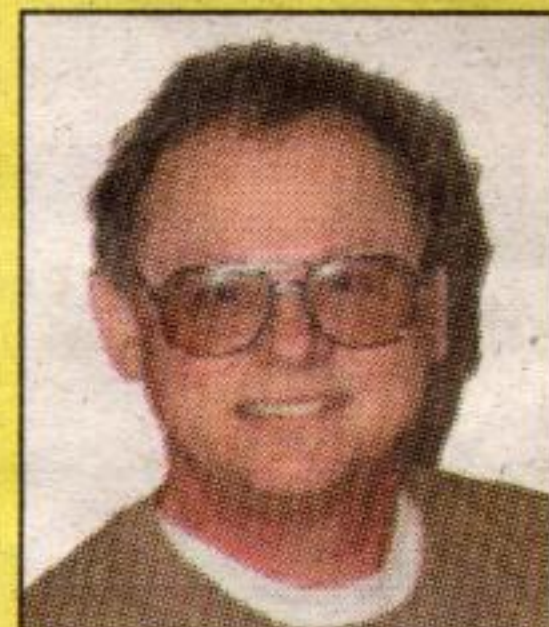
1. What role will you take on in your camp while in the wilds of Halton Hills? i.e. leader, hunter, gatherer...
