## Bach Chorale set to perform *Messiah*

The Georgetown Bach Chorale will perform the first part of Handel's *Messiah*, and the *Hallelujah Chorus* at its Advent concert tomorrow (Saturday).

Accompanying the Chorale will be a nine-piece baroque orchestra under the direction of Music Director Ronald Greidanus. Guest artists featured in the performance will be soprano Abigail Wong, mezzo soprano Pamela Gibson, tenor Peter McCutcheon, and bass Jason Nedecky.

Canada's leading baroque trumpet player, Norman Engel, will be featured in Telemann's *Trumpet Concerto in D major*. In this performance he will per-

form on both slide and valveless trumpets, a unique feature not often heard in today's concerts.

Also on the programme, the choir will perform the *Advent Cantata No. 70* by J.S. Bach

The concert will take place at Knox Presbyterian Church, Main St. Georgetown, starting at 8 p.m. It will be repeated at St. James Anglican Church, Caledon East on Sunday, Nov. 28, starting at 3 p.m.

## Children's Chorus to sing about Christmas

Georgetown Children's Chorus performs its annual Christmas concert on Saturday, Dec. 4. Children and teens, ranging in age from five to 18, will be singing choral arrangements of everyone's favourite Christmas songs.

The Georgetown Children's Chorus, directed by A.Dale Wood, will perform *Christmas is...* at the Georgetown Christian Reformed Church, 11611 Trafalgar Road, Georgetown at 2 p.m. and again at 7 p.m. The five choirs that comprise the Chorus will sing a variety of popular and spiritual Christmas music that attempts to define the meaning of Christmas.

This year's Christmas concert, *Christmas is...* will feature songs recognizable to everyone. The Georgetown Children's Chorus is made up of five different choirs determined by age groups. They will perform a whole range of music, from a cute rendition of *Santa's Choir* performed by the Cherubs (5 and 6 years olds) to a very complex choral arrangement of *The Virgin Mary had a Baby Boy* sung by the Performance Choir. The Performance Choir is comprised of those choir members that meet an extra hour a week and want to perform more complex pieces.

Tickets are \$10 (adults) and \$7 (seniors and students). They will be on sale from 5-9 p.m. on Tuesday Nov. 30 at the Georgetown Christian Reformed Church. They will also be on sale at the door the day of the concert. For more information call 905-877-6841.

In its 13th season, the Georgetown Children's Chorus Christmas concert is a tradition within the community. It now has approximately 180 members which performs two to three major concerts a year as

well as participating in many community events. This spring the choir will take a look back at their 13 years and perform a "best of" concert with some of the most popular and favourite songs from the past at the John Elliott Theatre. In May 2005, the Chorus will be travelling to Holland to take part in the 60th anniversary of its liberation.

## Local artists selected for One of a Kind craft show

Georgetown artist Laura Kingsbury, fabric artist Bonnie Glass and glass blower Paull Rodrique have been chosen to exhibit at the 30th Annual One of a Kind Christmas Show & Sale, Nov. 25 to Dec. 5 at the National Trade Centre, Exhibition Place, Toronto.

This is a juried show in which only one in three who apply are accepted.

Kingsbury is one of Canada's leading wildlife and nature artists, working in watercolours, acrylic and pastels. She is best known for her sensitive portrayals of birds, especially the songbirds. She is a member of Artisans Attic in downtown Georgetown.

Glass is designs in her studio Melange at the Williams Mill Visual Arts Centre. She explores the elements of line, texture, and colour combined with functionality in her clothing line.

Rodrique, a Toronto artist, also has a studio at Williams Mill.


