

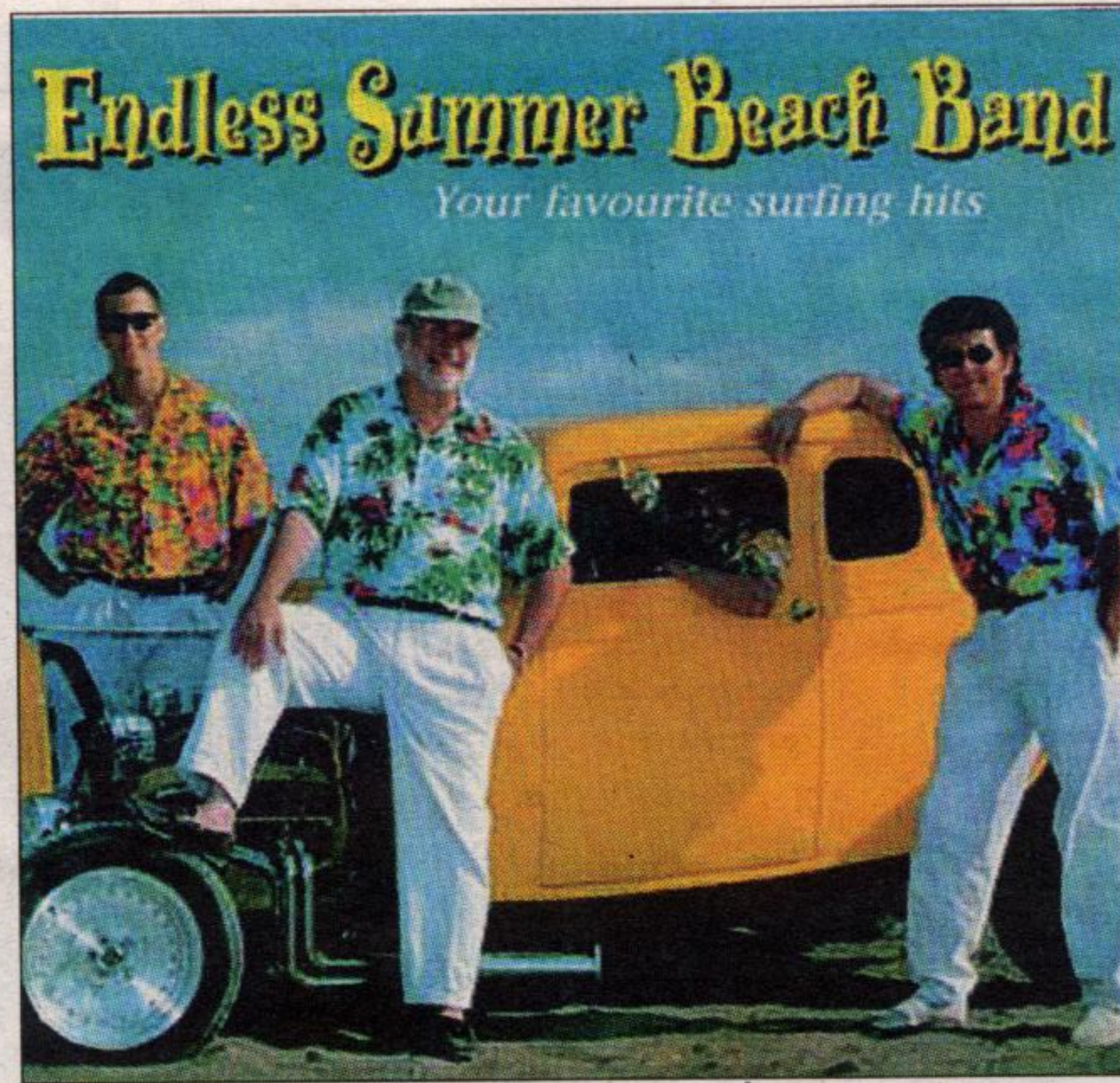
Get your tickets soon for Big Chill Dance

Town to get health team

Georgetown is one of the first communities in Ontario to receive funding for and have a family health team approved by the provincial government.

The team—Halton Hills Family Physicians Family Health Team—was announced by the government recently, along with 51 other teams to be set up in communities across the province.

Family Health Teams (FHT) include doctors, nurses, nurse practitioners and other health care professionals working together to provide comprehensive care day and night, seven days a week. This includes access by phone to a registered nurse.

"A family health team is exactly what our community needs," said MPP Greg Sorbara, the regional Minister for the Greater Toronto Area on behalf of Health and Long-Term Care Minister George Smitherman.

The government is creating 150 FHTs over the next three years.

Sorbara said FHTs will deliver care where its needed most and help take some of the pressure off of hospitals.

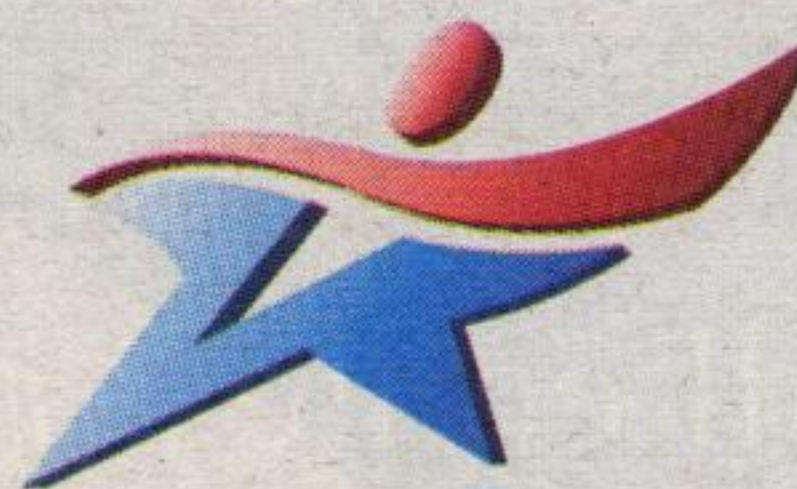
