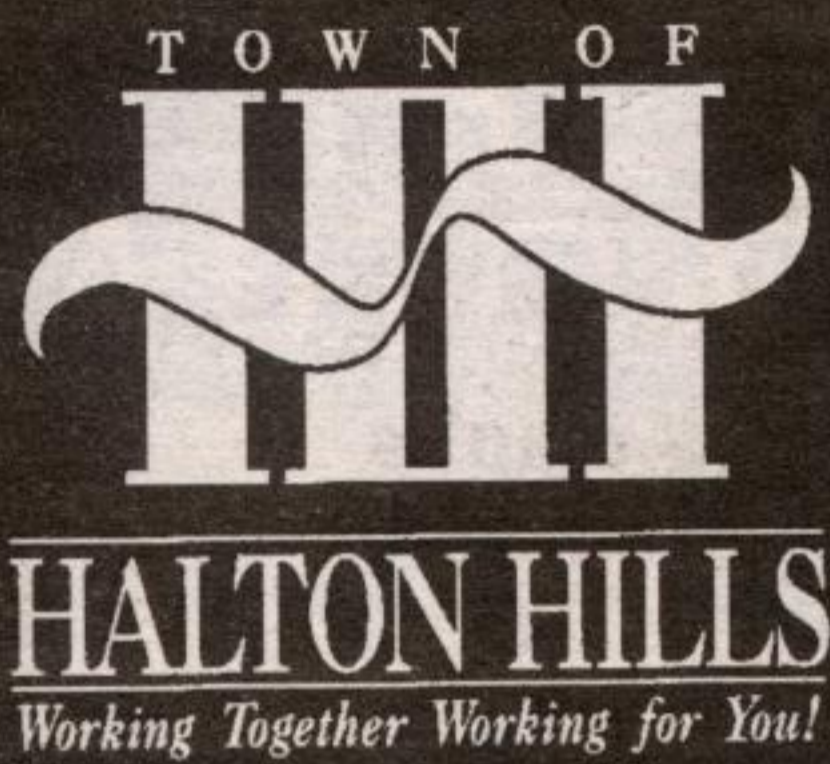

Pavement Management

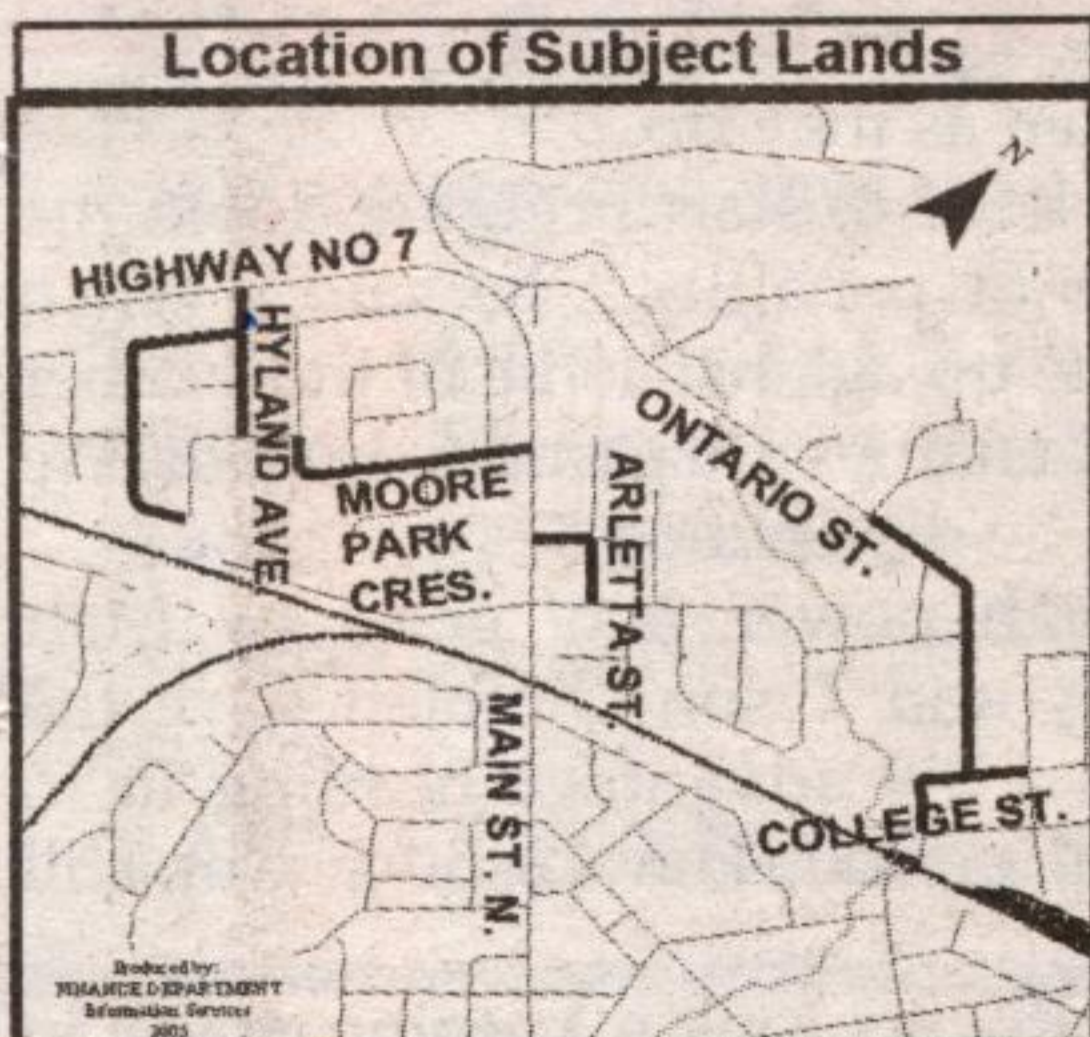
The Town of Halton Hills is proposing to resurface the following roadways under the 2005 Pavement Management Contract:

- Windsor Road (Guelph St. to Delrex Blvd.)
- Carole Street (Windsor Rd. to Delrex Blvd.)
- Ontario Street (Jason Crescent to College Street)
- College Street (Victoria St. to John St.)
- Kennedy Street (Main St. to Arletta St.)
- Arletta Street (Kennedy St. to Ewing St.)
- Hyland Avenue (Hwy. 7 to Joycelyn Cres.)
- Moore Park Crescent (Main St. to Joycelyn Cres.)
- Joycelyn Crescent (Hyland Ave. to Park Entrance)

The work on each section of roadway will vary but will generally include, asphalt removal/replacement, drainage improvements, curb and structure repairs and landscaping, as required.

The Pavement Management project is expected to begin in mid July with completion this fall.

Raiders dump Hawks to square RBC record

And with 49 seconds still remaining on another penalty, the Hawks, who led the Central Jr. A League with a 22.1 per cent power play efficiency, had a golden opportunity to get back in the game. However, the Raiders limited Hawkesbury to one harmless shot during the five-minute power play.

Most of the Hawks' chances came from close range but the Raider goalie used his quick reflexes to thwart every opportunity.

"Barrow steals another one for us," Sweazey said. "He's the goalie I like having on my team."

The victory was a critical one for the Raiders. Both Georgetown and Hawkesbury lost their openers and the loser would fall into last place at 0-2. And the Raiders still have to play the Camrose Kodiaks, who have established themselves as the early favourite by winning their first two games. But

next up is another critical game against Portage. Along with Georgetown and Weyburn, they form a logjam at 1-1.

Weyburn beat the Raiders 4-3 on Sunday. After losing a double overtime game to Portage the night before, the host Red Wings struck quickly, scoring just 90 seconds into the game by capitalizing on a Raider turnover. John Wheaton evened things up, scoring on a shorthanded breakaway but the Wings scored twice in the second period to take a 3-1 lead.

Frank DeAngelis gave the Raiders some hope, scoring with nine minutes to play but Weyburn restored its two-goal advantage on a two-on-one break three minutes later. Gurtler's goal with two seconds to play made the score a little more palatable but came too late for the Raiders to mount a comeback.

Monday's win seemed to boost the Raiders spirits and with a day off to prepare for
