 Remove crumbs and food residues from counter tops and furniture.

 Clean floors of food and liquid spills.

When Choosing Pest Control Products

Pest control products serve a useful purpose, protecting us from pests that spread disease, cause injury, and damage plants. Before choosing a product, homeowners should be encouraged to . ask themselves the following questions:

1. Is my pest really a problem, or can I live with it? If you do think you have what could be an infestation on your hands, consider your options.

2. Can I remove the problem by hand or tool? Would a barrier or alternative planting solve my problem?

3. What products are available for me to choose from?

Leave yourself time to read labels when you get to the store, and make sure you pick the right product for the task at hand. When choosing products, always:

 Read labels before purchasing to ensure you are choosing a product made to address your pest problem.

 Speak with store staff or call the toll free information numbers noted on the package label for additional information.

 Carefully follow all label instructions.

· Use only what you need. Rinse sprayers and containers and apply the rinse water to the target site.

 Follow disposal directions and wash hands when the job is finished.

Safety in the System

Whether made from organic or synthetic ingredients, all pest control products must be tested and registered with Health Canada's Pest Management Regulatory Agency before they are allowed in Canada.


