Barbara Coloroso, a parenting guru, is coming to Georgetown and Milton to speak about how parents can break the cycle of bullying.

Barbara will be speaking from 1-3 p.m. on Monday, May 30 in Milton at the South Side Community Church located at 2850 Derry Rd. She will be speaking the same evening at Georgetown District High School located at 70 Guelph St from 7- p.m.

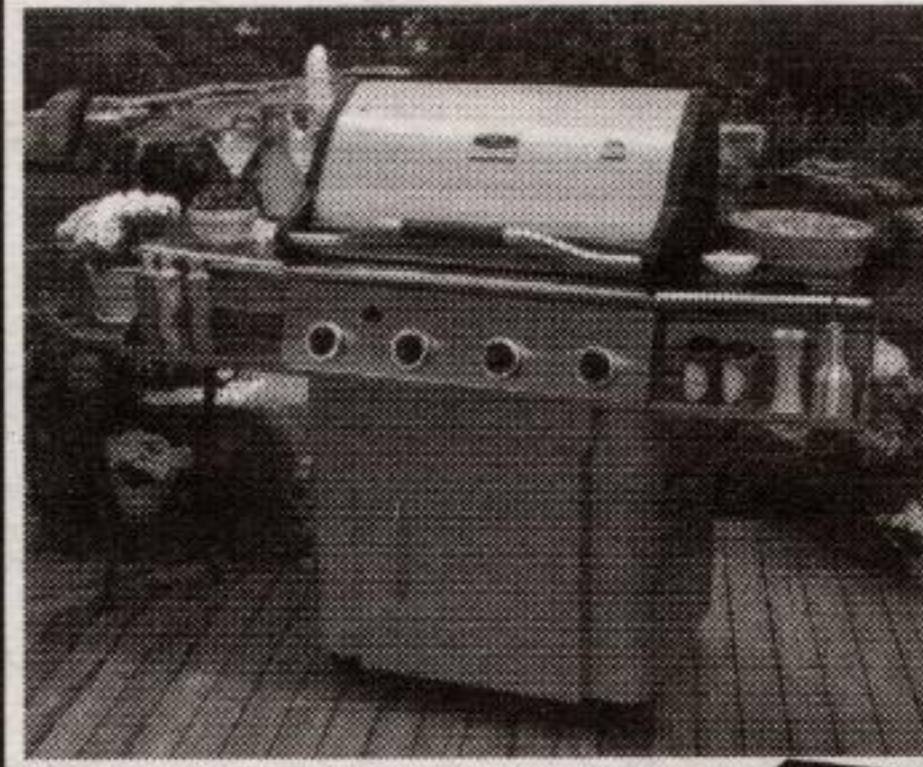
