



Georgetown South Community Node - Master Plan & Urban Design Guidelines

Work is nearing completion on the Georgetown South Community Node Master Plan & Urban Design Guidelines (MP & UDG) Document and we would like



The Town of Halton Hills Official Plan designates these lands as "Community Node", which is intended to provide an activity node for the Georgetown South Community, accommodating a mix of uses in a street oriented, pedestrian-friendly manner.

However prior to any development taking place within the Community Node, a comprehensive Master Plan/Urban Design Guidelines Document must be prepared and adopted by Town of Halton Hills Council.

The MP & UDG Document has been prepared to establish direction regarding detailed land use and the physical character and form of development in the Georgetown South Community Node.

Town Planning Staff and the Community Node Landowners have prepared the MP & UDG Document and are now seeking Public comment and input prior to Council adoption.

Interested persons may view the MP & UDG Document on-line at the Town of Halton Hills website www.haltonhills.ca, or by visiting the Planning Department at the Civic Centre.

Comments will be received by Friday June 3, 2005. Staff's Recommendation Report will be presented to Council at their meeting on Monday June 13, 2005, where Council will make the final decision.

WEED CONTROL ACT

NOTICE TO RESIDENTS AND PROPERTY OWNERS **REGARDING NOXIOUS WEEDS**

The purpose of the Weed Control Act R.S.O. 1990 is to reduce the impact of noxious weeds on the industries of agriculture and horticulture. This act applies to agricultural and horticultural lands that generate income or other benefits to agriculture. This excludes lawns, gardens and private areas for personal enjoyment and leisure.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that unless noxious weeds are destroyed by June 6, 2005 and as often as is necessary throughout the season to prevent the ripening of their seeds and the dispersal of their pollens, the Town of Halton Hills may enter onto private property and destroy these weeds. The costs will be charged against the property owner and collected in the manner of municipal taxes.

IN URBAN AREAS the Weed Control Act does not apply to noxious weeds or weed seeds that are far enough away from any land used for agricultural or horticultural purposes, as they do not interfere with that

The following are designated as noxious weed in the Town of Halton Hills.

Ragweed

Rocket, yellow

Sow-thistle, annual,

Barberry, common Buckthorn, European Carrot, wild Colt's-foot Dodder Goat's-beard Hemlock, poison Johnson grass Knapweed Milkweed Poison-ivy Proso millet,

black-seeded

perennial Spurge, Cypress Spurge, leafy Thistle, bull Thistle, Canada Thistle, nodding Thistle, Russian Thistle, Scotch

Vetchling, ruberous

Complaints regarding dandelion and golden rod will not be accepted, as these are not considered noxious weeds, pursuant to the Weed Control Act.
