

Having a blast at Bang-o-Rama

Robson wants aggregate firms to pay more to municipalities

t the May 30 council A meeting, rural Councillor Joan Robson will ask for her colleagues' support to request the Ministry of Natural Resources to up the royalty payment paid to the town from aggregate companies.

The resolution follows a similiar resolution sent to the MNR from East Gwillimbury.

According to the Aggregates Act 1990, aggregate companies must pay to the municipalities they are operating in a four cent per tonnage payment to help pay for road reconstruction or pit rehabilitation.

Robson, citing the increase in costs of road repairs and maintenance as well as other services, says that 15-year old payment should be increased to nine cents/per tonnage annually.


YOU ARE INVITED NOTICE OF ADDITIONAL PUBLIC OPEN HOUSE HALTON DRAFTTREE BY-LAW
