

30 artisans taking part Annual knitting, crocheting show starts May 31

Stitches and Chains The Art of Knitting and Crocheting will feature knit and crochet items done by more than 30 local artisans.

The show, presented by Halton Hands In Motion Knitting & Crocheting Guild, runs May 31-June 11 at The Gallery, Cultural Centre, 9 Church St., in Georgetown. Admission is free.

Janet Turner, promotions coordinator for the guild, said on display at the bi-annual show will be "everything from toys to interior décor items to clothing (for all sizes and age groups.)" Some of the

items will be for sale.

She said this year many of the artisans have created items based on a song, book, movie or memorable life experience. For example, one guild member has knit a tunic vest inspired by the *DaVinci Code* and another has crafted an objet d'art based on *The Diviners*.

At the show, raffle tickets will be available for two blankets—one knit, the other crocheted. The knit blanket is made up of squares done by the guild members. Tickets are \$2 each, or three for \$5.

All money raised through the ticket

sales will go to the Canadian Breast Cancer Foundation.

Turner said at the show, the guild will also be launching another initiative- Knit for the Cure. There will be a display of scarves, knit from designer patterns. The patterns for the scarves will be for sale at Georgetown Yarn & Crafts, and a portion of the proceeds will go to the Canadian Breast Cancer Foundation.

Event hours are Tuesday to Thursday from 9:30 a.m. to 8:30 p.m. and Friday and Saturday from 9:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. For information call 905-877-1521.

Banners banned on section of Hwy. 7

The Ontario Ministry of Transportation, concerned by liability, has forced the Town of Halton Hills to remove two banner poles on MTO-owned lands on Hwy. 7, east of Hall Rd.

The MTO had only just recently become aware of the existence of the poles, which had been used for many years by local groups to string banners to promote their events, such as the United Way campaign.

Town Engineer Rick Henry said a new location for banner poles has been found on Town-owned lands, just west of Hall Rd. Staff are now getting pricing for new poles, he said.
