# Annual knitting, crocheting show starts May 31

Turner said at the show, the guild will also be launching another initiative- Knit for the Cure. There will be a display of scarves, knit from designer patterns. The patterns for the scarves will be for sale at Georgetown Yarn & Crafts, and a portion of the proceeds will go to the Canadian Breast Cancer Foundation.

### Banners banned on section of Hwy. 7




