Peewee III Bulldogs

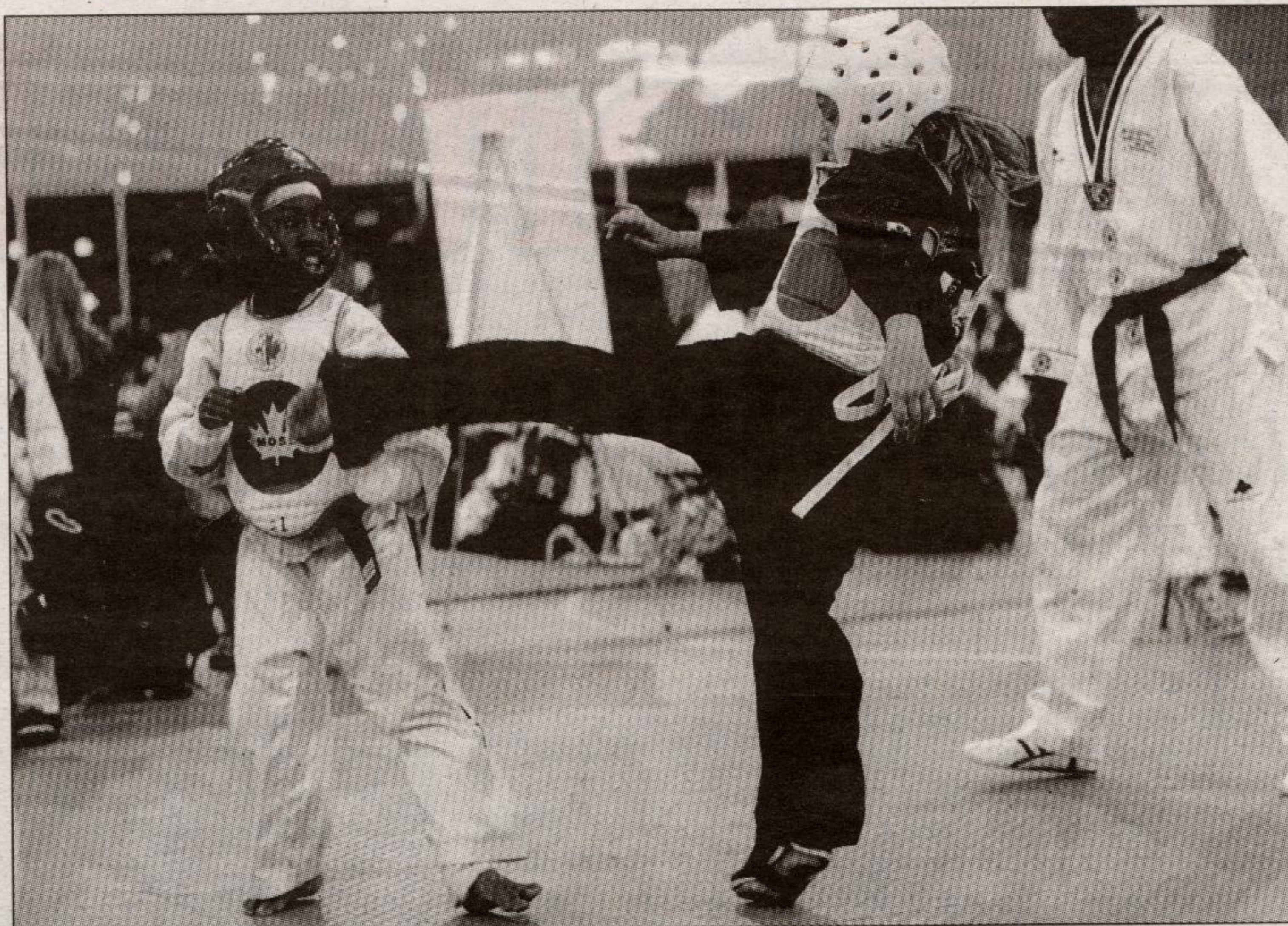
Dylan Britton fired two goals to lead the Halton Hills Peewee III Bulldogs to a 5-4 win over Mimico.

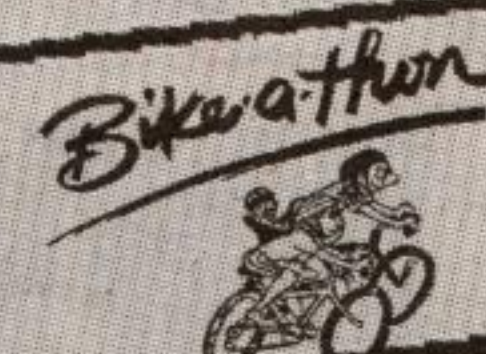
