## Health networking meeting set for May 31

The Halton Region Health Department will host a free workplace health networking meeting Tuesday, May 31.

The session has been designed for human resource professionals, occupational health nurses, health and safety representatives and wellness committee members.

The networking meeting is being offered as a result of suggestions from professionals who've attended previous workplace health events hosted by the health department, including the Working Well in Halton Symposium held last November.

The meeting will provide a forum for participants to network with other professionals, as well as an opportunity to discuss workplace health issues, share success

stories and suggestions for implementing workplace health programs.

There will also be an opportunity to discuss topics and ideas for future meetings, as the health department plans to offer a series of networking meetings throughout the year.

"With over 200,000 employees in Halton, it is important for organizations to make a commitment to workplace health to improve the health of their employees, their organization and the Halton community," said Halton Medical Officer of Health Dr. Bob Nosal.

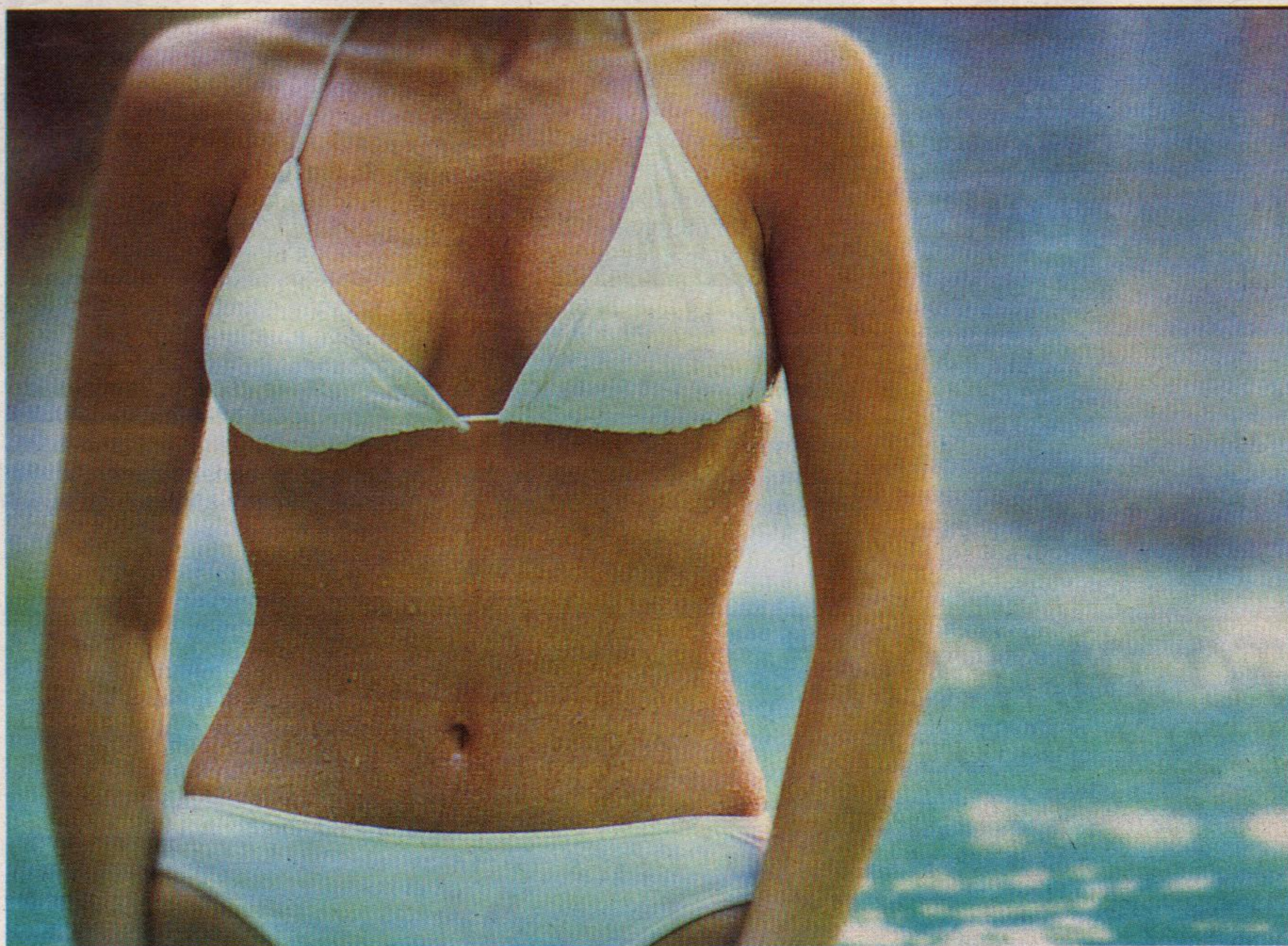
