will help get the trip underway. This also helps parents understand their children's needs, preferences and concerns as they get ready for the trip.


MAKING THE TRIP LAST A LIFETIME



If you've answered "yes" to several of these questions may mean that you have a hearing problem and it strongly suggests that a hearing check is necessary.


