To boost tobacco control efforts Region health department to get provincial cash

Halton Region has been approved for more than \$350,000 in provincial funding to boost the health department's tobacco control efforts.

Staff applied to the Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care earlier this year for \$1.4 million in tobacco control funds and recently found out it's been awarded \$354,000 of that request.

- The money will be used this year to:
- Increase compliance checks of local tobacco retailers
 - Increase enforcement of tobacco

control legislation

- Engage in a variety of educational and health promotion activities designed to reduce tobacco use and discourage tobacco advertising
- Provide grants to local high schools for student-driven tobacco control projects. High schools in Halton will be eligible for a grant of up to \$1,000 per school.
- Hire temporary staff on contract to



December 31 to deliver services associated with the new funding. This will include a public health inspector, tobacco enforcement officer, health promoter and students.

Regional council approved increasing the health department's 2005 tax supported operating budget by \$354,000 at its meeting Wednesday to accommodate the provincial dollars. It also supported adding the temporary staff to the budget.

It's not known yet if more tobacco control funding will be available to the Region next year.
