Teenager charged after school board employee's vehicles are vandalized

Halton Police charged a Halton Hills boy Monday in connection with vandalism to two cars owned by a Halton Board of Education employee.

Police report on Monday, June 27 a rock was used to scratch profanity onto two vehicles at the male employee's Halton Hills home. A neighbour's car was also vandalized.

Police allege that two teenagers, who both attend the school where the man works, were responsible for the incident and have charged a 17-year-old Halton Hills boy with mischief. A second boy is being investigated.

Police would not identify the school.

A Georgetown woman was charged after money was stolen from the Hurricane Katrina Relief Fund box at the Mountainview Road Tim Hortons on September 12.

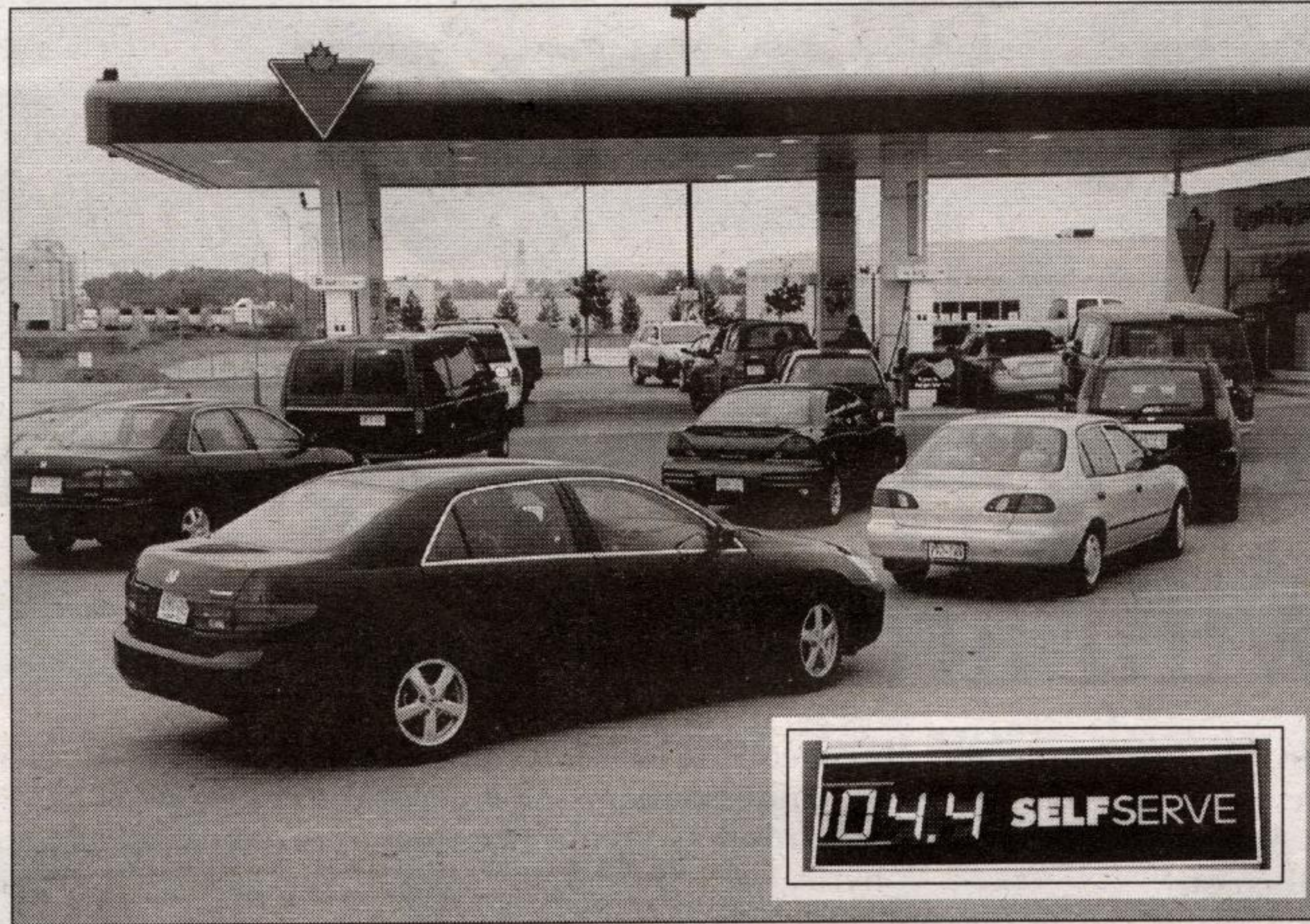
Halton Police report the theft of the drawer from the box was captured on security videotape, which was reviewed, and the woman alleged to have taken the money was identified.

Police report some of the money was returned.

Charged with theft under \$5,000 is Sharon Papadimitriou, 24, of Wylie Circle.

An additional charge of theft under \$5,000 was laid against Papadimitriou after \$19 worth of items were taken from Georgetown Canadian Tire on Monday.

Halton Police report someone attempted to break into a Hwy. 7 home late Saturday or early Sunday by prying and cutting a screen on a window at the home. No entry was gained.

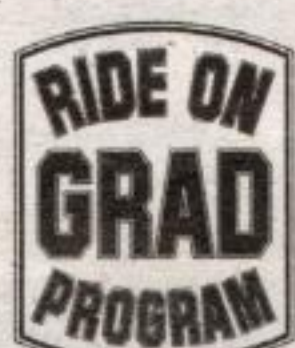
